**+Diocesan "White Mass":** Bishop Weisenburger will celebrate a "White Mass" at Sacred Heart Cathedral in Salina on Wednesday, October 18, at 7 pm. A white Mass traditionally is celebrated for members of the healthcare profession which includes, but is not limited to, the following: doctors, nurses, healthcare chaplains, medical technicians, employees of hospitals and long-term care facilities, hospice workers, and home-healthcare workers. Just as the Church reaches out to the sick with the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, so too does the Church reach out with prayer for those involved in the healthcare ministries. Equally welcome are those who do not work or minister in the healthcare profession, but who wish to gather with us to pray for healthcare workers. There is perhaps no better way to express our gratitude for their dedication and devotion to our beloved sick. All are warmly invited to attend this special Mass, with a reception following in the Hall of Bishops.

**+Emergency Collection for Hurricane Victims:** In recent days, all of us have been following the historic flooding in southeast Texas. Hurricane Harvey has created an unprecedented and catastrophic weather event. Our hearts and prayers go out to the families that have lost loved ones and to all who have lost homes or businesses, along with their sense of peace and normalcy. 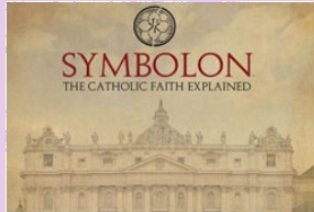
