Seven Dolors

Did you know that the word "dolors" is Latin for "sorrows"? This understanding brings the name of our church into new light. The Seven Sorrows of Mary are found in the prophecy of Simeon. When Mary and Joseph went to present Jesus in the temple, Simeon told Mary that during her life, Seven Swords would pierce her heart. The Sorrows can be seen in the entry way of our church and can be seen as swords in a stained glass window by the altar.

The Sorrows are:

The Prophecy of Simeon.

The escape and Flight into Egypt.

The Loss of the Child Jesus in the Temple of Jerusalem.

The Meeting of Mary and Jesus on the Way to the Cross

The Crucifixion of Jesus on Mount Calvary.

The Piercing of the Side of Jesus, and His Descent from the Cross.

The Burial of Jesus by Joseph of Arimathea.
