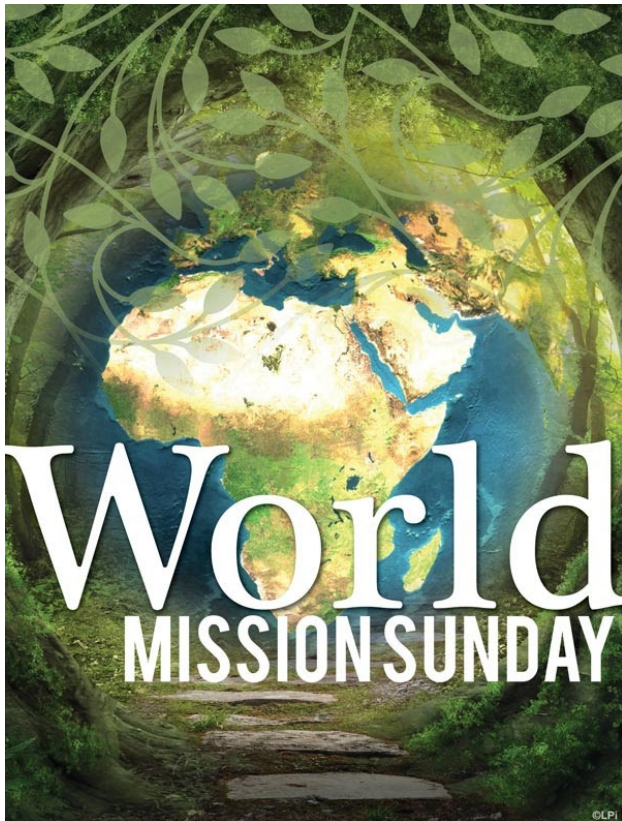

Christ himself relied on the hospitality of others during the three years of his public ministry. He used the meals and shelter provided to Him, as a chance to teach. Many of the parables focus on hospitality. Every month, the Knights of Columbus and the Seven Dolors Catholic Women offer us their hospitality in the form of food, drink, and conversation. As you leave the church on these Sundays, take a moment to partake in a tradition that can be traced back to the very beginnings of our faith.
