## AUGUST 25, 2024 + 21ST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### How to prepare for this Sacred Event, Entering the Sacred Space, Physically and Spiritually

This preparation actually begins at home, by recognizing that we are going to a Sacred Event, the most important thing we can do for ourselves in this life, to receive Jesus Christ body, blood, soul and divinity. We should dress in a way that reflects that understanding. Once arriving at the church, we greet others with the joy of the moment as we approach the nave. Entering the nave, our demeanor should change, reflecting the recognition that we are in the presence of Christ. Blessing ourselves with Holy Water in recognition of our Baptism and genuflecting (if able) as we prepare to enter the pew.

Once in the pew, and prior to the Introductory Rite, the people should enter into a period of quiet reflection. (A personal note here: it is a beautiful thing when the people come together to say the Rosary, or any other devotional prayer and a period before the Mass is appropriate for this, as long as there is a period [approximately 10 minutes] for quiet reflection before Mass begins. This seems to be about the norm in our parishes, I only mention it for the purpose of clarity.) This is a time for us to dismiss all of our angst and frustrations, and to quiet our minds so as to be open to God's message to us. Since we are addressing silence, the GIRM specifies a number of times in the Mass when silent reflection is important and should be given proper attention. These times are: within the Penitential Act, after the invitation to pray (intro to the Collect), after each of the Readings, after the Homily and then after Communion. These are momentary silences, a few seconds up to 30 seconds where proper, and should not disturb the flow of the Liturgy.

One more point to make before we begin our journey through the Mass is that there are prayers designated for the priest and prayers designated for the people. The prayers are specified in the Rubrics in the Missal but here are a few general rules that can make it easier for everyone: When the priest says, "The Lord be with you" or something similar, the people always respond, "And with your spirit." Any time an "Amen", "Alleluia" or a "Blessed be God Forever" response is prompted, it is a prayer of the people. The Mystery of Faith acclamation, the Doxology after the Our Father, and the Lamb of God are also prayers of the people.

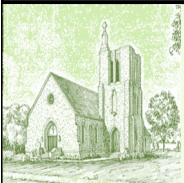
