## SEPTEMBER 1, 2024 + 22ND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### Participating at Holy Mass: The Introductory Rite

Okay, we made it through the precursory stuff, now we can get to the meat of the matter. We are at the church, we have entered and made the Sign of the Cross with Holy Water & renewed our Baptismal Promises. We made our sign of reverence (for most of us that is a genuflection) as we entered our pews (I think some of us still have our names on them from the pew rental days.) and settled ourselves for what is about to take place.

The ministers are gathering at the entrance and the musicians are taking their positions, time to begin. The GIRM expresses the beauty and importance of singing in the Liturgy, and gives biblical references to support its position. It is good then to begin the Liturgy with song as the procession enters the Sanctuary, this should be done whenever possible. Songs sung in the Liturgy should be reverent and if possible have some relevance to that day's Liturgy. All should stand as the entrance hymn is sung and the procession moves to the altar and makes a sign of reverence, if the ministers are able, this is normally a genuflection. Any servers and lay ministers then move to their positions as the priest(s) and deacon(s) who are present move to reverence the altar with a kiss before continuing to their places.

During the Introductory Rite, at the conclusion of the entrance hymn, the celebrant leads the people in the Sign of the Cross and then a greeting that recognizes God's presence in the assembly. The people's response "And with your Spirit" is an affirmation of the mystery of the Church present being joined to the eternal celebration. A brief introduction to the Mass of the day may be made by the presider or a deacon.
