Participating at Holy Mass: The Penitential Rite

Next is the penitential act that calls us to recognize our failure to do God's will in our lives and to love each other as God loves us, we are called to take a few moments to recall our shortcomings. This is the first opportunity within the Liturgy to have our venial sins forgiven as all confess that we have faults and ask openly for the prayers of all the faithful to help us to live better. The penitential act concludes with the presider giving general absolution (this is not equivalent to Sacramental absolution in Confession which is necessary for mortal sins). Then, unless included in the penitential act, the Kyrie Eleison (Lord have mercy) is chanted or said either in Greek or the vernacular recognizing God's merciful love for us.

The Kyrie is followed by the Gloria in Excelsis (Glory to God in the Highest), this is the ancient hymn by which the Church united in the Spirit venerates the Father and the Son, the Lamb of God slain for us and asks that our sins be forgiven and peace granted. Proper reverence demands that the hymn be stated (sung or said) in its entirety and not modified or substituted. The Gloria is sung or said on all Sundays outside of Advent and Lent, and on Solemnities and Feasts (and a few other more solemn celebrations).

Following the Gloria, the presider calls the people to prayer, at which time all are given the opportunity to experience God's presence and lift up their intentions for the Mass. The priest then prays the "Collect" a prayer that is generally formulated to express the people's desire to know God's love for them. It is universally stated in a Trinitarian formula. The people are called to respond with an "AMEN" making the prayer their own. This prayer concludes the Introductory portion of the Mass.
