Participating at Holy Mass: The Liturgy of the Word

At the conclusion of the Collect Prayer everyone is seated, this is the indication that we are changing modes. Up to this point everything that we have done is directed prayer, now we are moving into an instructive phase and the seated position is appropriate for instruction/listening.

The Liturgy of the Word is intended to allow us to reflect on God's direct communication with us through the Scriptures. Thus, the readings should never be rushed and as stated before silent periods are very important, it is also important for there to be some familiarity with what is about to be read. It is critical that the lectors are prepared to present the Word, but it is of equal importance for each of us to be prepared to receive the Word. A good way for that to happen is to read through the Mass readings the night before or even just before Mass, this can be done alone or with the family. An extra three to five minutes thus used will vastly improve the Mass experience for everyone.

All the Mass readings are to be done from the ambo and the first two readings should each be read by a lay lector (on weekdays there is only one). The Gospel Reading is always to be done by a deacon or priest, and the presiding priest should only read if there is no other priest or deacon available.

As we begin the Liturgy of the Word it is appropriate for the presider to make a brief comment introducing the readings, this is not often done in the US. The lector then approaches the ambo and announces the first reading, this should be read from the Lectionary with nothing added to what is written; the reading follows. This reading almost always has a tie to the Gospel reading, though sometimes it is pretty obscure. Each reading should conclude with "The Word of the Lord." To which everyone responds with robust thanksgiving, "Thanks be to God!!"
