SEPTEMBER 22, 2024 + 25TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Participating at Holy Mass: The Readings

The first reading (usually from the Old Testament, but during Easter and Christmas New Testament readings are used) is always followed by a responsorial Psalm, which is to be sung if possible, during which everyone promptly dozes off... Just kidding, but often I don't believe that proper attention is given to this reading from the Scriptures which is carefully chosen to correspond with the readings for the day (occasionally, the Psalm will be fitted with the celebration or feast of the day, but this is the exception not the rule). We should listen attentively and respond joyfully to the verses read as we sing/pray these ancient praises to God from the Old Testament Fathers (usually David or Solomon).

The second reading follows the Psalm, and is usually from the Epistles (Letters). This reading follows what is called a semi-continuous path, meaning that it is likely a continuation of the previous week's reading. It concludes just like the first.

The "Alleluia verse" is sung prior to the reading of the Gospel, the GIRM specifically states that it is to be sung/chanted, it gives no option for it to be read. This verse is the people's recognition that what is to follow is Our Lord's direct communication to us in His "Good News", the sung/chanted verse is our profession of faith in His Word, and is done while standing. During Advent and Lent, when the word "Alleluia" is not used for communal prayer, another acclamation is substituted by the rubrics.

Everyone remains standing for the reading of the Gospel, the priest or deacon declares that the Lord is present, saying, "The Lord Be with You," to which the people respond *exuberantly*, "And with Your Spirit." The deacon/priest introduces the Gospel, and the people respond again, "Glory to You, O Lord!" The rubrics call for the Gospel reader to make a Sign of the Cross on the book, then on his forehead, lips and heart. It is customary for the people to cross their forehead, lips, and heart while saying quietly, "May God be in my mind, on my lips and in my heart as I receive the gift of the Gospel message." or some similar prayer. The Gospel is then proclaimed and at the conclusion the reader acclaims, "The Gospel of the Lord." And the people reply *with great enthusiasm*, "Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ!"

The words in italics are my own emphatics.
