Participating at Holy Mass: The Homily, Creed and Universal Prayer

The people are then seated (as is appropriate for a period of instruction) as homily follows the reading of the Scriptures and may only be omitted for the gravest of reasons on Sundays Feasts and Holy Days, it is optional but recommended at all other Masses. The homily normally uses some part of the Mass of the Day as its focus, and the Gospel is the most common focus by far. It is acceptable though, to speak on some event that has great impact on the local or universal Church, when it is prudent to do so (e.g. Sept 11th in the US, or the wars in Ukraine and/or Israel). I was taught that a good homily should be to the point, and the point should not be too broad. I was also taught that while a bad homily may improve by being abbreviated, no good homily was ever made better by making it longer. These two things are always in the back of my mind as I prepare for my own homilies. A brief period of silence after the homily is recommended to allow for reflection.

The Creed always follows the homily on Sundays and other solemn celebrations, it may be sung or said (I don't believe I have ever heard it sung at any local parish), but the people are always to participate in its recitation. This is an opportunity for the reading and the homily to be linked in our minds with the great truths of our faith as we verbally affirm our system of beliefs.

The Liturgy of the Word always concludes with the Universal Prayer, or the Prayer of the Faithful. This series of petitions and thanksgiving allows the faithful to exercise their baptismal priesthood in participation with the community to pray for unity, healing, salvation and blessings on the whole Church and the world we live in. The GIRM specifically calls for prayers for the needs of the Church, for public authorities and the salvation of the world, for those burdened by difficulties of life, and for the local community, living and deceased. Other petitions may be added as necessary, but these four should always be included.

If the presider has been completely successful, the people should be, at this point, ready to join in the celebration/sacrifice which is already and always occurring in Heaven. Their minds and hearts should be completely focused on what is about to occur in front of them. But success in this area relies as much on the attitude of the people as on the presentation of the truths of the gifts they are to receive. That is the beauty and the curse of God's gift of free will. *Let us choose wisely.*

The words in italics are my own emphatics.
