Participating at Holy Mass: The Liturgy of the Eucharist

Everything we have accomplished up to this point has been intentionally drawing us into a closer relationship with God and our Lord Jesus Christ, preparing us to join ourselves to Him in the Eucharistic Sacrifice. We have now reached the point where we symbolically join ourselves in the offering of the gifts at the altar, but we also really join ourselves to the Lord and each other in spirit, and in The Spirit.

Christ instituted the Liturgy of the Eucharist at the Last Supper, the night before he died for us. It is in our commemoration of this event that we make Christ's sacrificial offering ever present to the Church. It is in this banquet feast that we offer our own lives, the good and the bad, the joys and the suffering, to the life of Jesus which is about to be offered to the Father for the redemption of mankind. In the most real way this offering is occurring at the heavenly banquet in eternity, but because it was given to us by Christ we can join ourselves to that banquet here in time, each time we offer it. Because we are joining ourselves to the one eternal Mass, we should always strive to fulfill our part in a way that honors that reality. We cannot improve on the heavenly banquet, so we should not look to add our own ideas and actions to the ritual. One of the most beautiful things I realized about our Church in my travels around the world is that no matter where you go, or what language is spoken where you are, the Mass is the Mass, you always feel at home when you are there.

The Liturgy of the Eucharist begins by setting the Altar, which is both the Eucharistic table and the sacrificial platform, in preparation for the celebration. Then the bread and the wine, along with the other gifts of the faithful are processed to the Altar and offered freely to the priest (or deacon) to be prepared for sacrifice. It is appropriate for there to be a chant or hymn during the offertory rite (even if there is no procession) which should continue at least until the gifts are brought to the altar. It is good for us to remember that these gifts are symbolically ourselves (bread) and our labor (wine) offered with Christ.

The priest blesses the gifts and places them on the altar as he pronounces the prescribed formulas either quietly or out loud. Once complete, the priest ritually washes his hands, at one time this was a practical need, as the priest might have received animals or grain during the offertory, today it is primarily symbolic of the priest's desire for interior purification. The Prayer over the Offerings calls the people to a posture of prayer, the people rise as the priest invokes a heavenly blessing over the gifts, to which the people a firm AMEN.
