## OCTOBER 13TH, 2024 + 28TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### Participating at Holy Mass: The Liturgy of the Eucharist

We have reached the highpoint of the Mass (and truly the Source and Summit of our faith), in which the offering of Christ himself, and his people with him, is made to the Father. The Eucharistic Prayer in a real way is the fullness of prayer in which the Son communicates His love for the Father and the Father receives the Son's gift of himself. The Prayer involves a number of elements,

There is always a **thanksgiving**, usually offered in the preface. The preface is designed to call attention to the purpose of the Mass being said on that day and to give thanks to God.

The **acclamation**, in which the whole people join themselves to the realm of the heavenly in the *Sanctus* (Holy, Holy, Holy). This is to be chanted or sung, when possible, as this is how it is described in the Book of Revelation.  
(The People kneel at this Point)

The **epiclesis**, the prayer invoking the Holy Spirit to act through the priest to effect the miracle of Consecration, that the bread and wine should become the Body and Blood of Christ.

The **Institution narrative and the Consecration**, this is where the Sacrifice is effected using the words and acts that Christ gave us at the Last Supper. An act, a mystery, he commanded the Apostles to continue into perpetuity.

The **anamnesis**, the fulfilling of Christ command to celebrate His Blessed Passion and Death, His Resurrection, and Ascension into heaven.

(The Profession of Faith is the People's pronouncement of affirmation to the mysteries)

The **oblation**, the Church's offering of the unblemished sacrificial victim (to whom they are now joined) to the Father, with the primary intention of unity with God and each other becoming everything to us.

The **intercessions**, expressing that the Eucharist is desired to be celebrated in communion with the whole Church, saints, angels, living and deceased souls, called to participate in the redemption and salvation purchased by the Body and Blood of Christ.

The **concluding Doxology**, by which the glory of God is expressed and affirmed by the presider and to which the people alone respond with the great AMEN.
