Participating at Holy Mass: The Liturgy of the Eucharist

As we prepare for the Lord's Prayer, we have a great opportunity for discussing prayer posture. Many people have strong feelings about this, especially as it relates to this part of the Mass. (The paragraph below is the product of my research, but it does fall in line with what has come out of the Vatican in recent years when the question arises.)

There has arisen a great debate as to whether the people should hold hands or use the Orans (hands extended) posture during the Lord's Prayer, the GIRM only specifies when the presider should use the Orans and never calls for the people to use it. There have been attempts to make it official; these have all failed to be approved. Any writings I have been able to find expressly discourage the holding of hands, some seem to lean towards the use of the Orans for the people. My only point is that no one has the right to arbitrarily add anything to the Mass, and we are called to be one as an assembly of the people. Therefore, I personally discourage (as the Church would seem to) the use of the position by anyone other than the presider, and for him only when specified by the rubrics.

The Communion Rite, through which we respond to Christ's command that the faithful should receive His Body and Blood as food, begins with the call to pray as Christ taught us. The Lord's Prayer is the perfect example of what it means to pray. It includes all the forms of prayer, those being: Praise (Blessing) and Adoration, Thanksgiving, and Supplication (Intention and Petition). During Mass, the Lord's Prayer is concluded with an embolism said by the priest. A doxology (For the Kingdom...) is said by the people as a response, the presider is not supposed to share in this response.
