## OCTOBER 27TH, 2024 + 30TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

**Participating at Holy Mass:** We left off last time with the Our Father and the Doxology, which is focused on the vertical aspect of our communal relationship (our relationship with God). Now we move on to the sign of peace, where we focus on the horizontal aspect of our relationship (our relationship with each other).

While having a Biblical root, the sign of peace, as we know it today, was implemented with the Novus Ordo. And what the action looks like is the most varied thing within the Mass, it should be remembered that this act takes place during the most sacred part of the Mass and should not detract or distract from that sacredness. I have been in parishes where the sign of peace is a long and contracted event where people leave their pews and walk all over the sanctuary to greet others and I have been in parishes where the pastor has decided that the people do not need to be involved at all in the sign of peace. Based on my reading of the rubrics and the GIRM something between these two extremes is what is intended. After the celebrant has offered Christ peace to everyone, and the deacon or priest gives the invitation, the celebrant is supposed to greet the concelebrants and deacons present, the others present are to greet several of those in nearest proximity to them (no leaving the pew). The greeting can be a wave, a hand shake, or a hug or kiss when appropriate. The sign of peace should be completed prior to the ciborium arriving at the altar from the tabernacle.

The presider then preforms the fractioning rite while the Agnus Dei (Lamb of God) is said/sung and a small piece of the fractured host is added to the Chalice to show the unity of the Body and Blood as the priest prays quietly for the work of salvation to be completed. The Sacred Species are then shown to the people with the invitation to the Supper of the Lamb. The priests and deacons present then receive the Eucharist under both kinds. After the priests and deacons, the Eucharist is distributed to the extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, who should only enter altar area after the presider receives the Precious Blood. Once the Sacred Vessels have been distributed the ministers move to their location for distribution to the people. The Communion Chant, which can begin as soon as the celebrant receives, is intended to be sung by all as a sign of unity in the union of their voices. It is *strongly recommended* that the Communion Chant be a Psalm associated with the antiphon of the Mass, local bishops can approve other liturgical music. The psalmody can, but is not required to, continue throughout the distribution of Communion until the vessels are purified. If not sung, the antiphon should be read.

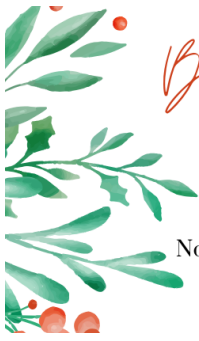

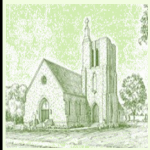
