Bishop Vincke has asked all 86 parish in the Diocese of Salina to start or grow their regular opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration.

What is Eucharistic Adoration?

We can show our adoration to God in many ways, but in Eucharistic Adoration, we spend time adoring Jesus face-to-face, who is truly present, body, blood, soul and divinity, in the Blessed Sacrament.

Why is This Spiritual Campaign Important?

Spending time in Eucharistic Adoration draws us into intimacy with Jesus. As we get closer to Him, He gives us the peace, wisdom and strength to serve his Church and the people he has placed in our lives.

When Does the Spiritual Campaign Start?
