OCTOBER 26, 2025 + 30TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Continuing with the message from last week's Gospel, the first reading today reminds us that God hears prayer and responds. Just as love is better received by a person that is open to being loved, God's response to our prayers is better received by one who is humble enough to be open to what God provides. If we are seeking only what we believe will satisfy our needs, we might miss out on many of the blessings that God desires for us.

The second parable of Jesus in today's Gospel addresses attitude in prayer. In contrasting the prayer of the Pharisee with the that of the tax collector, Jesus teaches his disciples to pray in humility before God. Jesus again surprises his listeners by showing the tax collector as the example of faith, rather than the Pharisee. Remember that Pharisees, a sect of Judaism, taught a rigorous interpretation of the Law of Moses as the basis for Jewish piety. If anyone would be a model for prayer, a Pharisee was a likely candidate. In contrast, tax collectors were collaborators with the Roman authorities in a system that allowed the tax collectors to line their own pockets by charging more than the defined taxes. Yet, in this parable, Jesus offers the humility of the tax collector as a model for the prayer of a disciple. The parable reminds us that when we pray, we must remember our need for God in our lives. If we are too full of ourselves, there is too little room for God's grace to work in us. **Humility is key to being right with God.**

God provides strength in difficult times. In the second reading, Paul writes about being deserted by friends but supported by the Lord, highlighting that God helps us through our trials. Go to God, ask for what you think you need and then watch as God gives you what you really need. Humbly receive it and go out and make use of it.
