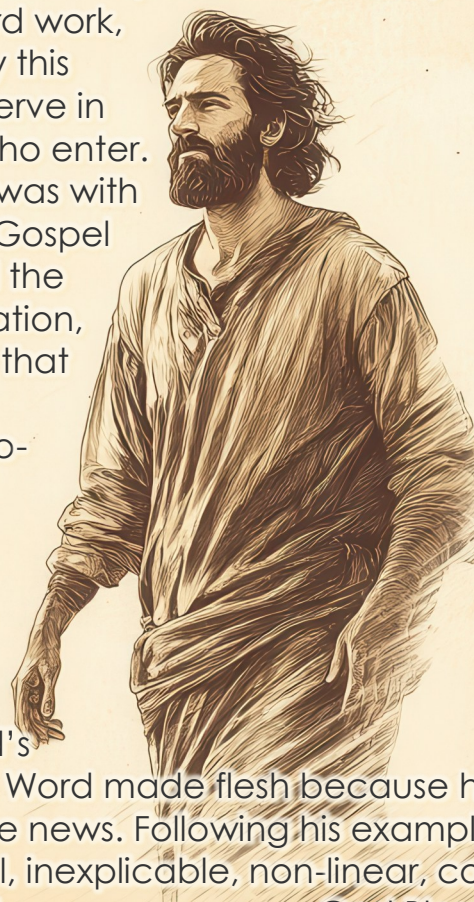
## JANUARY 18, 2026 + SECOND WEEK OF ORDINARY TIME

Before I begin the reflection for this week, I want to sincerely thank all those who dedicated so much time to making the Christmas season special. I especially want to thank those involved in music ministries for their hard work, which added so much beauty to our Liturgies. May this year see a multiplication of those who choose to serve in these ministries for the good of the Parish and all who enter.

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." St. John begins his Gospel with this sweeping, mystical poem about God and the nature of God. St. John tells the story of the incarnation, a new way to tell the oldest story ever told, a story that has lasted through the millennia.

After introducing us to the Word, the gospel introduces us to John the Baptist. Both messenger and prophet, he sets the stage for us. He says:

"After me comes a man who ranks ahead of me because he was before me." John is not speaking of chronology, but of ultimate precedence. John the Baptist twice tells us that he did not know the man of whom he spoke. He was not aware of God's full plan; he simply knew that he had glimpsed the Word made flesh because he had seen the Spirit and he was convinced to spread the news. Following his example, let us move beyond ourselves, toward the most beautiful, inexplicable, non-linear, contradictory story. The story, our story, begins with the Word.
