## APRIL 26, 2026 + FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

For five upcoming weeks (pausing for the Ascension and Pentecost) we will be discussing the Precepts of the Church. What they are and what we as Catholics are required to do to sustain our full communion in the Church through them.

The Precepts of the Catholic Church are the mandatory minimum actions that ensure a basic commitment to prayer, liturgy, and sacramental life. They are defined by the Catechism of the Catholic Church (art. 2042-2043) as essential for the faithful's growth in love of God and neighbor.



### The Five Precepts of the Church

- ✦ **Attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation:** Catholics must participate in the Eucharist and rest from unnecessary servile labor on Sundays and appointed feast days.
- ✦ **Confess Sins at Least Once a Year:** The faithful must receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least once, traditionally during the Lenten season, to ensure a state of grace.
- ✦ **Receive the Eucharist at Least During the Easter Season:** Catholics are required to receive Holy Communion at minimum once per year during the Easter time.
- ✦ **Observe Days of Fasting and Abstinence:** Individuals must follow the Church's rules regarding fasting and abstinence (specifically Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, and Fridays in Lent).
- ✦ **Provide for the Needs of the Church:** Catholics are obliged to support the material, financial, and pastoral needs of the Church according to their abilities.

According to The Holy See, these precepts are considered the absolute minimum to maintain communion with the Church and to grow in spiritual life and failure to abide by them is a grave moral wrong. Deeper study of these precepts reveals what God, and the Church, desires for us.


