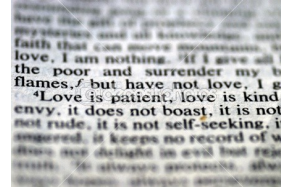
**SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING** Those needing the Sacrament of Anointing may call the parish to schedule a time with one of the priests.

## The Sign of Peace & Flu Season

Because we are in the midst of the cold and flu season, we recommend refraining from shaking one another's hands. A wave of a hand or a nod with eye contact and a smile is a healthier method of participating in this significant aspect of the Mass, and may help curb the spread of illness.

Prevention of a cold or flu includes washing your hands often with soap and water and avoiding close contact with anyone who is or has been ill.

## LEARNING ABOUT THE DOCUMENTS OF THE 2ND VATICAN COUNCIL

October 11, 2012, marked the 50th anniversary of the opening session of the Second Vatican Council. The Council produced 16 Conciliar documents. Parish Staff Members have taken time to summarize the documents and their thoughts will be shared with you through the Bulletin, one document per week.

### Decree on the Media of Social Communications, or *Inter Mirifica* as summarized by Stacie Levendofsky, Office Manager/Secretary

"*Inter Mirifica*" or the Decree on the Means of Social Communication, was the second document issued by the Vatican II council fathers, in December of 1963. It served as a guidepost with regards to the methods and tools of modern media. Though referring, at the time, to the then-present means of communication, "the press, the cinema, radio, television and others of a like nature", the document would prove to be prophetic in terms of how social communications would expand and advance through our society.

*Inter Mirifica* sought first to state that social means of communications should be governed by moral law and used for the common good of society. Without this moral intent, media would become a means for spreading evil and manipulation of the public.

Consumers of media were also addressed in *Inter Mirifica*, being admonished to take responsibility and use moderation and discipline in their utilization of social communication, including mindfulness of moral law and informed consumption. Young users were urged to seek a deeper understanding of the message being delivered through discussion with elders and experts. Parents were reminded of their duty to shield children from inappropriate content.

Secondly, the Church was called to more effective use of social communications for evangelization and service, stating that, "it is the Church's birthright to use and own any of these media which are necessary or useful for the formation of Christians and for pastoral activity." The document went so far as to pronounce ignoring the potential use of modern media by pastors "shameful". It advised that clergy, laity and makers of media be thoroughly instructed and receive complete formation so their use and creation of media could most benefit society.

According to *Inter Mirifica*, the principal moral responsibility for the proper use of the media of social communications falls to the makers. They should endeavor never to oppose the common good. Public authorities are obligated to encourage spiritual values and should protect the freedom of information. *Inter Mirifica* is thought to have overturned a previous Church position that condemned some press freedom due to 'poisonous' media content.

In addition to the release of *Inter Mirifica*, World Social Communication Day was created by the Vatican II Council to provide an annual message to the Church's people and the rest of the world. Later, Pope John Paul II advocated responsibility and positive goals in Social Communication. In 2010, Pope Benedict XVI called for priests to become digital citizens and engage with the information society, saying, "Priests stand at the threshold of a new era: as new technologies create deeper forms of relationship across greater distances, they are called to respond pastorally by putting the media ever more effectively at the service of the Word". He called the use of social communications, "a pastoral outreach capable of making God concretely present in today's world."

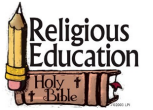

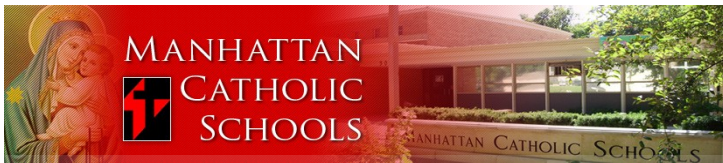

### BOY SCOUT SUNDAY

### PADRE FELIPE



*The Missionaries of the Eucharistic Heart of Christ the King (order of our sisters from Mexico) was founded by Padre Felipe de Jesus Chaparro y Ruiz in 1942 for the purpose of evangelization through devotion to the heart of Jesus.
