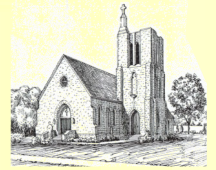

BIBLE STUDY WITH FR. MERLIN

A BIBLE STUDY on Hebrews & the Catholic Epistles will be led by Fr. Kieffer on the **5 Mondays of Lent, from 7:00-8:30pm** in the Church basement. Bring a Bible. Call or email the Parish Center for attendance so that sufficient copies of the materials can be prepared.

Hebrews is the New Testament book most devoted to explaining the relationship between the Old Covenant made with Israel and the new covenant established by the death of Jesus Christ. It is widely used in the Liturgy of the Church. The Catholic Epistles are the 7 letters addressed to the entire Christian community, not to a particular Church as Paul's writings were.



As outlined in a previous bulletin this quarter, the "Stewards of Hope" is a pastoral plan for the Diocese of Salina. The plan has four phases, with each phase divided into sections. Each section deals with one aspect of the Diocese's life as a Christian community. In the year of 2013, we are in the Third Phase, "Life and Family". The concentration continues, during January through March 2013 on Section Seven: "Marriage and Family". The second and final Parish Level Objective for Section Seven of the Third Phase is as follows: Parish Level Objective 2 for Section Seven: "The Clergy, parish/pastoral council(s) and Family Life Commission(s)/Coordinator(s) of a parish or group of parishes are encouraged to promote and support Catholic marriage and family life." This effort may include various programs, workshops, social events, conferences, etc. Therefore, as a parishioner of Seven Dolors, please reflect on the above Objective 2 for Marriage and Family and note the following questions: *What would you like to see happen? What are your ideas?* Please respond to Rosie Rundell with your thoughts.

LEARNING ABOUT THE DOCUMENTS OF THE 2ND VATICAN COUNCIL

October 11, 2012, marked the 50th anniversary of the opening session of the Second Vatican Council. The Council produced 16 Conciliar documents. Parish Staff Members have taken time to summarize the documents and their thoughts will be shared with you through the Bulletin, one document per week.

Declaration on Christian Education or *Gravissimum Educationis*, proclaimed by Pope Paul VI on October 28, 1965 as summarized by Bettina Boller, Director of Religious Education

The Sacred Ecumenical Council has deemed education as an important facet in every person's life. Not only is it urgent to educate young people, but also to make available the continued education of adults. Christians are called to be children of God through the rebirth of water and the Holy Spirit, and the right to a Christian education.

"For a true education aims at the formation of the human person in the pursuit of his ultimate end and of the good of the societies of which, as man, he is a member, and in whose obligations, as an adult, he will share."

Parents are bound to educate their children and must be recognized as the primary and principal educators. But the family also needs the help of the community as a whole. So certain rights and duties belong to society whose role is to direct what is required for the common good. And finally, the family needs the help of the Church, whose duty it is to give an education by which a person's life will be filled with the spirit of Christ and thus promoting the complete perfection of the human person and the good of society.

"The sacred synod, while professing its gratitude to priests, Religious men and women, and the laity who by their evangelical self-dedication are devoted to the noble work of education and of schools of every type and level, exhorts them to persevere generously in the work they have undertaken and, imbuing their students with the spirit of Christ, to strive to excel in pedagogy and the pursuit of knowledge in such a way that they not merely advance the internal renewal of the Church but preserve and enhance its beneficent influence upon today's world, especially the intellectual world."
