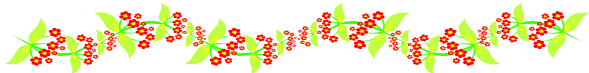

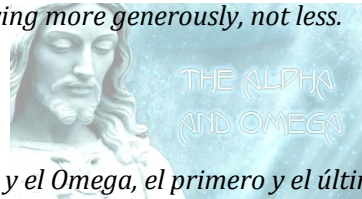
SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING Those needing the Sacrament of Anointing may call the parish to schedule a time with one of the priests.

A STEP IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION...

Seven Dolors Church Step Project April 29, 2013 through June 7, 2013

Dear Parishioners:

We have arrived. Work began on the Church Step Project April 27th with the removal of trees and bushes (courtesy of the Knights of Columbus). Under the direction of Mike Crubel and with many generous volunteers, the front steps and ramp were demolished and hauled away (courtesy of Kelly Briggs). Our demolishing the steps and ramp (and eventually the cement area from the steps to the street) will save at least \$11,000 off the original \$70,000 bid from Kolde Construction Company.

Kolde began work on putting in the forms for the steps on Monday, May 6th. We are hoping (weather permitting) to pour the middle section of the steps on Friday, May 10th.

The City of Manhattan has agreed to do the work of replacing the curbing from the corner of Juliette and Pierre to the alley on Juliette (to provide for better drainage). They will not begin their work until May 23rd (the day after MCS has their last day of classes, as it is the City's preference to wait until school is out). We cannot pour the cement from the steps to the curb until the City is finished with the curb - this will allow us to have a perfect alignment.

In talking with Kolde, the City of Manhattan, and Mike Crubel, we have agreed that it would be better to continue to have weekend Masses in the School Gym through the first weekend of June. We do have a wedding scheduled for June 8th and we need to have access to the Church by that time. If the weather holds, and we progress without serious snags, we hope to be able to complete the project by Friday, June 7th.

Therefore, the new extended schedule for Masses at Luckey will be:

May 11th & 12th

May 18th & 19th

May 25th & 26th

All weekday/school Masses will continue to be held where they normally are scheduled, in either the Chapel or Church.

There are a few events in the Church, or its basement, that we will have to adjust to by using the side entrances. In the event of a funeral, we have discussed the possible venues.

I want to thank you for your continued patience and cooperation as we hold Masses at an alternate site. Your flexibility is greatly appreciated!

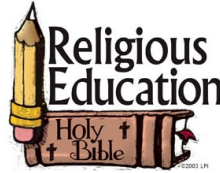

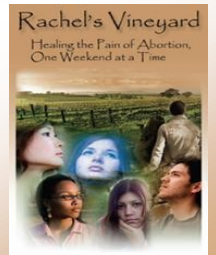

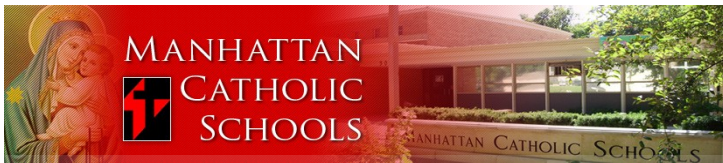
