**Seven Dolores Church Step Project**

April 29, 2013 through June 7, 2013

Dear Parishioners:

The Feast of Pentecost celebrates the birth of the Church. Since that moment when the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles; faith in Jesus Christ has spread through evangelization.

For the first 300 years following Pentecost, faith, celebrated in the form of worship in the Holy Mass, was held in secret. Following the legalization of Christianity in 313, great edifices have been erected to house Catholic Worship. These buildings do more than offer a place to worship; they also inspire our thoughts and souls to the glory of God.

In 1920, the Catholic Community of Manhattan, under the patronage of the Seven Dolores of the Blessed Virgin Mary, sacrificed to build a beautiful house to worship and praise God. Ninety-three years after that time, we have inherited this beautiful house of prayer.

Over the past few weeks, work through volunteers and the Kolde Construction Company has progressed very rapidly. At the time of printing for this bulletin, the steps themselves have been poured and much of the work completed on the new wheelchair ramp. Work is beginning on tearing out and replacing the concrete that runs from the steps to the street. The City of Manhattan will be re-grading the street and replacing the curb beginning May 23rd.

While we are using the Luckey Jr. High Gymnasium this weekend, it may be possible to return to the Church next weekend. As you arrive next weekend, please watch for signs to determine where Mass will be held.

As we continue the finish work on the steps, we are already looking into the landscaping of the areas surrounding the steps. This is such an exciting time. As a parish, we are grateful for the generous donations to the Building Fund that are enabling us to complete this project. However, your donations are more important than ever as we look to the next projects of the Church. *Please use your green Building Fund monthly envelopes* to insure the upkeep and improvements of the Church and Parish buildings and grounds can continue! Please keep our volunteers and contracted workers in your prayers throughout this project.

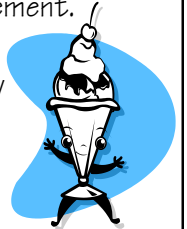
