**INFANT BAPTISM** Parents seeking to have their child baptized must call the parish office and schedule a preparation session, after which the baptism is scheduled.

**SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING** Those needing the Sacrament of Anointing may call the parish to schedule a time with one of the priests.

## HOLY HOUR WITH THE HOLY FATHER

On the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, Pope Francis will preside over a special Eucharistic adoration that will extend at the same time all over the world involving the cathedrals and parishes in each diocese. For an hour, at 5:00 PM (Rome time) the whole world will be united in prayer and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.



As part of the Year of Faith, Parishes throughout the world have been requested to join the Pope Francis in this Holy Hour of Prayer. The 5 pm hour in Rome coincides with the 10 AM Mass here on June 2nd. At that Mass, we will offer a special prayer in unison with the Holy Father. Parishioners are encouraged to visit the Adoration Chapel at that Hour (10 AM - Sunday), or if you will not be in Mass and unable to visit the Chapel, please take time to offer this prayer for Evangelization at 10 AM on Sunday as individuals or as families.

## Prayer for the New Evangelization

*"Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.' But how can they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how can they believe in him of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone to preach? And how can people preach unless they are sent?"*

—Romans 10: 13-15

Heavenly Father, Pour forth your Holy Spirit to inspire me with these words from Holy Scripture. Stir in my soul the desire to renew my faith and deepen my relationship with your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ so that I might truly believe in and live the Good News. Open my heart to hear the Gospel and grant me the confidence to proclaim the Good News to others. Pour out your Spirit, so that I might be strengthened to go forth and witness to the Gospel in my everyday life through my words and actions. ## Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary *La Novena al Corazón Sagrado de Jesús y el Corazón Inmaculado de María*



*A novena is based upon the nine days of prayer following the Ascension of Jesus until the Descent of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. Following the Feast of Corpus Christi (The Body and Blood of Christ) the Feast of the Sacred Heart is celebrated on Friday and the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary is celebrated on Saturday. Therefore, we begin this joint novena on the Friday after the Most Holy Trinity and conclude it on the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary.*

Remember, Heart of Jesus, Immaculate Heart of Mary, and you, O glorious St. Joseph, that no one has ever had recourse to your protection, or implored your assistance without obtaining relief. Animated with the utmost lively confidence, I come laden with the weight of my sins, to prostrate myself before you. O Merciful Heart of Jesus, Immaculate Heart of Mary, and you, O glorious St. Joseph, reject not my prayer and petitions but graciously hear and grant them. Amen.
