SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING Those needing the Sacrament of Anointing may call the parish to schedule a time with one of the priests.

MINISTRY OF CARE VISITATION GUIDELINES

Seven Dolors "Ministry of Care", through its priests and lay
volunteers, wishes to serve the spiritual needs of parishioners
who are hospitalized, homebound (temporarily or permanently),
or in a care facility-with Communion, Anointing, or an occa-
sional visit or call.

As noted on the parish website under "Care Committee",
federal law prevents hospitals from disclosing the presence of
any **patient** to others, even Church ministers, unless the patient or
their designated caregiver has signed the HIPPA release.

Therefore, priests and Catholic lay ministers **visiting the hos-
pital will not have a parishioner's name** on the Catholic list of
admissions when they go for Anointing or Communion unless the
patient or their "caregiver" asks the nurse to make sure he/she is
on the "**Catholic List**" and signs the required release.

By the same law, other care institutions like *Via Christi*,
Meadowlark, *Stoneybrook* and *Good Samaritan Hospice* cannot
reveal to us your presence or that of a family member. As a re-
sult we sometimes do not find out about a parishioner *in one of*
these care facilities for weeks or months. **A family member or**
relative must let us know!

Our first session of Grief-
Share will be Sept. 9 at 6:30 at
731 Pierre. It may be hard for
you to feel optimistic about
the future if you've lost a



spouse, child, parent, family member or friend. You've proba-
bly found there are not many people who understand the
deep hurt you feel. GriefShare groups meet weekly to help you
face these challenges and move toward rebuilding your life.
Each week the group watches a video seminar featuring top
experts on grief and recovery. These videos are produced in an
interesting-to-watch television magazine format featuring ex-
pert interviews, real-life case studies, dramatic reenactments
and on-location video. You may attend the GriefShare group
at any session; it is not necessary to attend in sequence. You
will find encouragement and help whenever you begin and can
always attend portions of the next cycle to view any of the vid-
eos you have not seen.

This first session introduces you to GriefShare. It also ex-
plains what living with grief is like, why you shouldn't be
ashamed of your grief and why you shouldn't rush through
your healing. For more information call Rosie at 785-565-

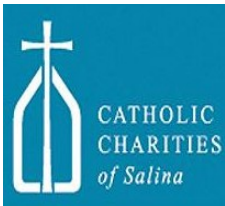
