INFANT BAPTISM Parents seeking to have their child baptized must call the parish office and schedule a preparation session, after which the baptism is scheduled.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE Couples seeking the Sacrament of Marriage must contact the parish at least 6 months prior to the intended date, and participate in sessions of preparation. Weddings are not scheduled in Advent or Lent.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING Those needing the Sacrament of Anointing may call the parish to schedule a time with one of the priests.

deep hurt you feel. GriefShare groups meet weekly to
help you face these challenges and move toward rebuild-
ing your life. Each week the group watches a video semi-
nar featuring top experts on grief and recovery. These
videos are produced in an interesting-to-watch television
magazine format featuring expert interviews, real-life case
studies, dramatic reenactments and on-location video.
You may attend the GriefShare group at any session; it is
not necessary to attend in sequence. You will find encour-
agement and help whenever you begin and can always
attend portions of the next cycle to view any of the videos
you have not seen.

This first session introduces you to GriefShare. It also
explains what living with grief is like, why you shouldn't be
ashamed of your grief and why you shouldn't rush
