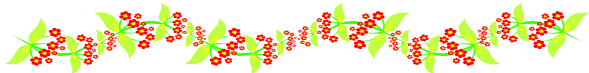

INFANT BAPTISM Parents seeking to have their child baptized must call the parish office and schedule a preparation session, after which the baptism is scheduled.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE Couples seeking the Sacrament of Marriage must contact the parish at least 6 months prior to the intended date, and participate in sessions of preparation. Weddings are not scheduled in Advent or Lent.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING Those needing the Sacrament of Anointing may call the parish to schedule a time with one of the priests.

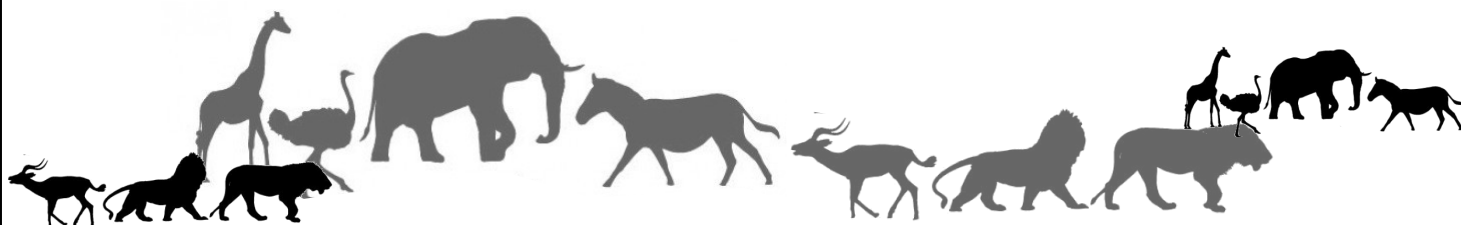

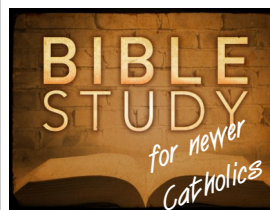

MINISTRY OF CARE VISITATION GUIDELINES

Seven Dolours “**Ministry of Care**”, through its priests and lay volunteers, wishes to serve the spiritual needs of parishioners who are hospitalized, homebound (temporarily or permanently), or in a care facility—with Communion, Anointing, or an occasional visit or call.

As noted on the parish website under “**Care Committee**”, *federal law* prevents hospitals from disclosing the presence of any **patient** to others, even Church ministers, unless the patient or their designated caregiver has signed the HIPPA release.

Therefore, priests and Catholic lay ministers **visiting the hospital will not have a parishioner's name** on the Catholic list of admissions when they go for Anointing or Communion unless the patient or their “caregiver” asks the nurse to make sure he/she is on the “**Catholic List**” and signs the required release.

By the same law, other care facilities like *Via Christi, Meadowlark, Stoneybrook and Good Samaritan Hospice* cannot reveal to us your presence or that of a family member. As a result we sometimes do not find out about a parishioner *in one of these care facilities* for weeks or months. **A family member or relative must let us know!**
