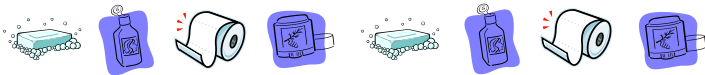

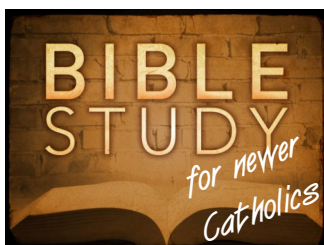
## PRAYER WORKSHOP

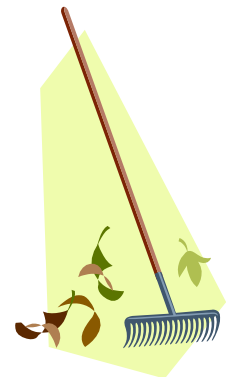
## Manhattan Catholic Schools 30th Annual Benefit Auction
