INFANT BAPTISM Parents seeking to have their child baptized must call the parish office and schedule a preparation session, after which the baptism is scheduled.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE Couples seeking the Sacrament of Marriage must contact the parish at least 6 months prior to the intended date, and participate in sessions of preparation. Weddings are not scheduled in Advent or Lent.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING Those needing the Sacrament of Anointing may call the parish to schedule a time with one of the priests.

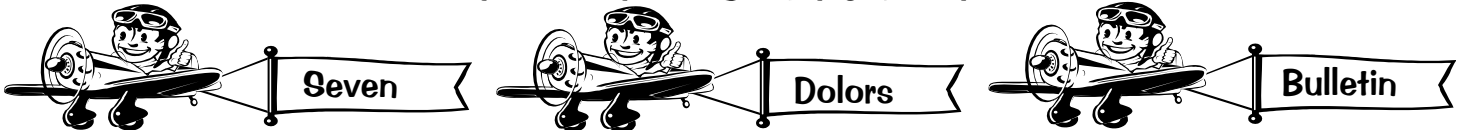


SURVIVING THE HOLIDAYS

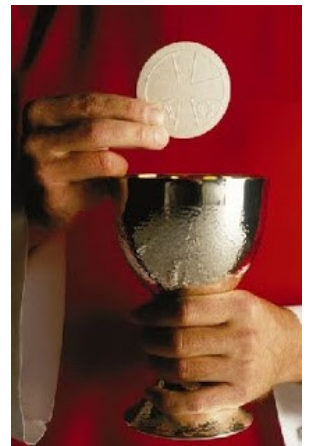

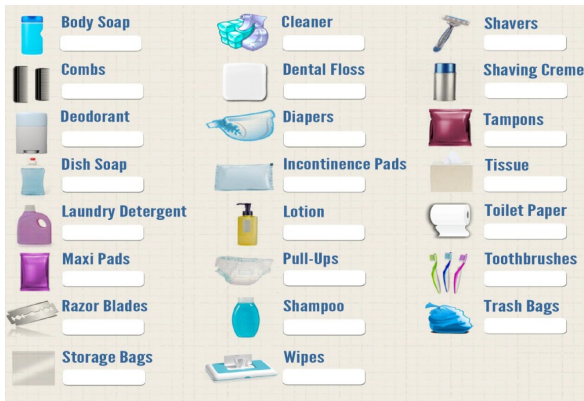

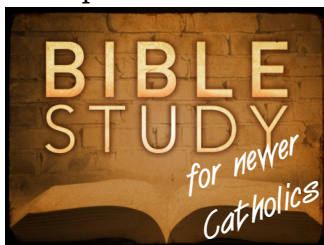


REGISTER SUBSCRIPTION SUNDAY

STEWARDS OF HOPE - As outlined in previous bulletins this year, the "Stewards of Hope" is a pastoral plan for the Diocese of Salina. The plan has four phases, with each phase divided into sections. Each section deals with one aspect of the Diocese's life as a Christian community. In the year of 2013, we are in the Third Phase, "Life and Family." The concentration continues, during these last three months of the year on Section Ten: "Human Dignity and the Sanctity of Life." The first Parish Level Objective for Section Ten is to "protect and affirm the dignity of every person and promote the sanctity of every human life, especially the most vulnerable and marginalized." Please take some time to give prayerful thought to the defense of human life. The following message is offered as a reflection and prayer: *"By our unflinching defense of human life and religious freedom, by our witness to the transcendent nature of the human person, and by our compassionate service to our brothers and sisters in need, may we spark a renewal of love and commitment to the true good of others. Only a love that seeks to serve those most in need, whatever the personal cost to us, is strong enough to overcome a culture of death and build a civilization worthy of human beings made in God's image."*
