INFANT BAPTISM Parents seeking to have their child baptized must call the parish office and schedule a preparation session, after which the baptism is scheduled.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE Couples seeking the Sacrament of Marriage must contact the parish at least 6 months prior to the intended date, and participate in sessions of preparation. Weddings are not scheduled in Advent or Lent.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING Those needing the Sacrament of Anointing may call the parish to schedule a time with one of the priests.

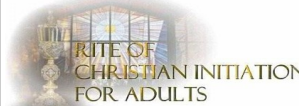

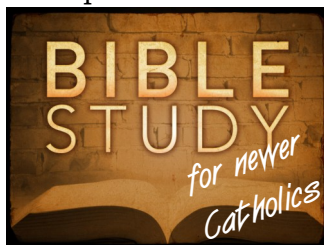
Women's Cancer Support Group

SMALL CATHOLIC CHAPEL IN GUATEMALA

Did you know that Guatemala receives over 60 earthquakes (of varying strengths) throughout the year. We have received word of a small village whose chapel was destroyed over a year ago. The community is slowly rebuilding their Catholic Chapel. They have requested any aid to help with doors, windows and electricity. This would cost 25,000 Quatales (or \$3,000 US dollars). The average monthly income is \$200-\$300 a month (or \$12.50 a day to \$18.75 a day). If this is a cause that touches your heart, donations may be written to Seven Dolors with memo Guatemala. Fr. Popelka has a contact that will ensure donations go directly to the cause.

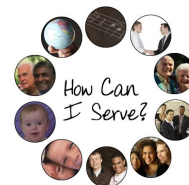


Stewardship Renewal

Responding to Jesus' Call to Minister to the Faithful

Our Financial Resources are a very guarded and private matter. We are to be reminded that all we have, including our ability to acquire wealth, is a gift from God. You are asked to be stewards of your resources on a regular basis to the Parish (through envelopes or automatic withdrawal) as well as to support parish-sponsored collections for the Diocese and other local needs (Charity or Building Funds, Food Pantry).
