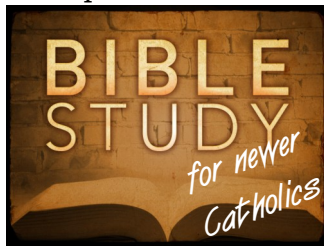
### MIDNIGHT MASS

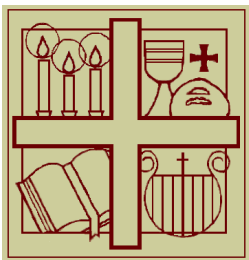


## Monday Masses During Advent
