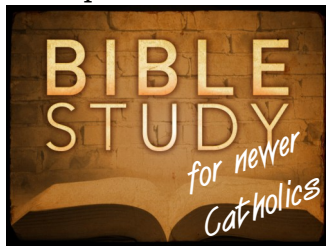
MIDNIGHT MASS

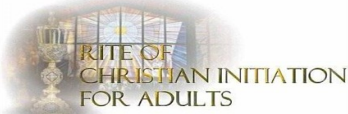

This month's lecture was delivered by Susan Reed, executive director of the Flint Hills Community Clinic. Susan gave the Council information on what the clinic is and who it serves. The clinic started in 2005 and now serves over 1500 low-income patients within

Manhattan. The clinic is funded only through donations and grants, and does not receive any

governmental funds. The clinic offers primary care and the opportunity to refer patients to specialists through a network of doctors and institutions willing to provide services for free or at a reduced cost. The lecture was very informative and was nice to see how lower income residents can receive the medical care they require.

Our famous KofC breakfasts are every second Sunday from now through May after the 8am and 10am Masses. Join us for pancakes, biscuits and gravy, French toast, sausage, scrambled eggs, and beverages. It's the best breakfast in town. Donations help our diocesan seminarians with their school expenses. This year we are sponsoring Omar Davila, who interned with Fr. Joe this past summer. Our next breakfasts are December 8 and January 12.
