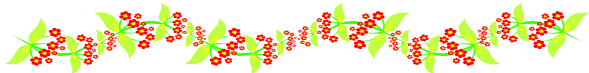

**INFANT BAPTISM** Parents seeking to have their child baptized must call the parish office and schedule a preparation session, after which the baptism is scheduled.

**SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE** Couples seeking the Sacrament of Marriage must contact the parish at least 6 months prior to the intended date, and participate in sessions of preparation. Weddings are not scheduled in Advent or Lent.

**SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING** Those needing the Sacrament of Anointing may call the parish to schedule a time with one of the priests.

## STEWARDSHIP THOUGHT

*"For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven."*  
Matthew 5:20

The scribes and Pharisees lived according to the letter of the law and they used this to elevate themselves above the other people. Jesus is clear – it's the love that you have in your heart that will get you to heaven. Simply following church rules out of obligation, not love, does not put you on the path to heaven. ### LIEAP

The Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP) is a federally funded program that helps eligible households pay a portion of their home energy costs by providing a one time per year benefit.

In order to qualify, applicants must be living at the address, be personally responsible for utilities at the residence, demonstrate a recent history of payments, and have a combined gross income (before deductions) of all persons living at the address that does not exceed 130% of the federal poverty level. If you are unsure about your qualification status or have additional questions, please call LIEAP at 1-800-432-0043.

**Studies have shown that a large portion of the residents in Kansas who may qualify are unaware of the program. If you think you may qualify for LIEAP assistance, a Westar Energy Customer Advisor will be available to assist you with the completion of the LIEAP application on Thursday, February 6, between 10 AM and 4 PM at Shepherd's Crossing, 621 Humboldt in Manhattan. Please bring proof income for all members of the household, Social Security numbers for all members of the household and utility account numbers.**
