INFANT BAPTISM Parents seeking to have their child baptized must call the parish office and schedule a preparation session, after which the baptism is scheduled.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE Couples seeking the Sacrament of Marriage must contact the parish at least 6 months prior to the intended date, and participate in sessions of preparation. Weddings are not scheduled in Advent or Lent.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING Those needing the Sacrament of Anointing may call the parish to schedule a time with one of the priests.

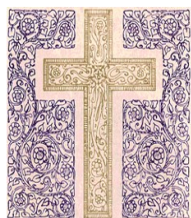
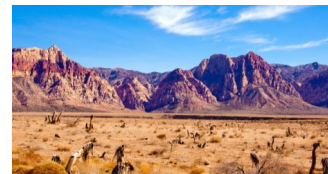

The children return to the Church during the collection time. Parents are welcome to go with their children for the first time to feel more comfortable with this beautiful ministry.

During our Lenten Journey, it is our time to reflect and think about the Father's great love for us. Our faith is a gift from God. Our thank you is how well we share that love with others. We reflect His love in our closing song, "We Adore You O Lord" in the Latin "Adoramus Te Domine". We will reduce the number of verses sung at the end of Mass, arriving at the end of Palm Sunday Mass, where we will end in silence to prepare us for Holy Week. Let us be mindful as we journey through the desert of Lent and share the deep thirst for the Living Water.

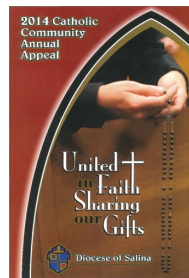

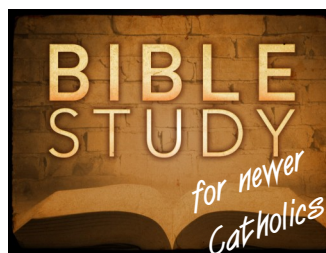

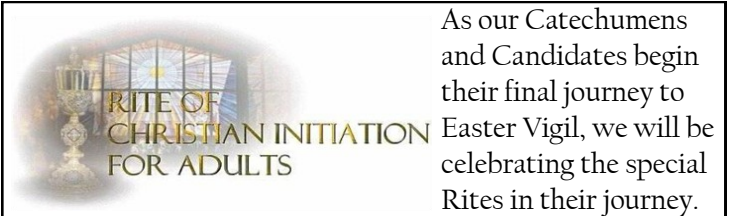


Spring Cleaning?

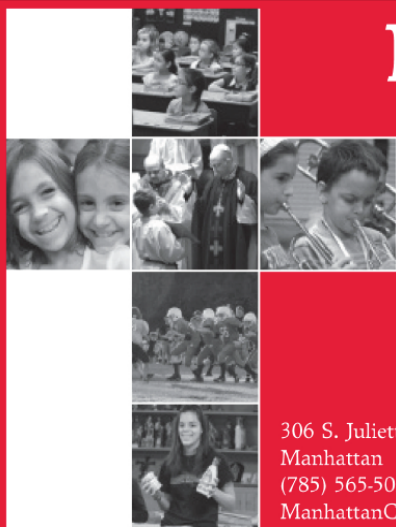
