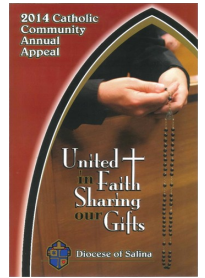

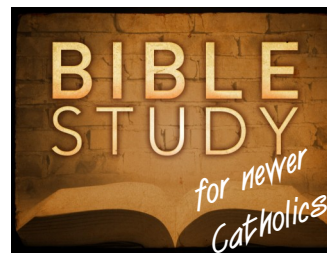

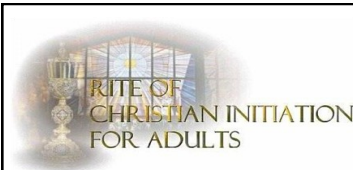

Puppet Liturgy Returns!

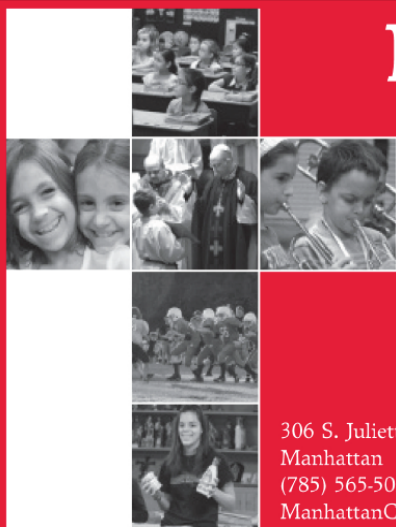


Update on the MCS Annual Fund Drive:
