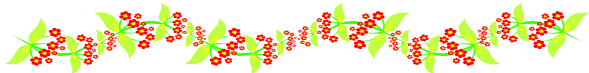

## Planned Protest-News from Fr. Joe

I received a rumor last week, and it was later substantiated that Westboro Baptist Church of Topeka will be picketing Seven Dolors from 9:30 am to 10:00 am on Sunday, July 20th. Our parish is one of three churches centrally located near downtown Manhattan being targeted. As far as we can tell, proximity is dictating the selection, and no other reason. Bishop Weisenburger is aware and offers this suggestion:

*I consider it, in some respects, to be an honor to be picketed by these people. As we are true Christians, we must respond from our true calling. My expectation is that the parishioners of Seven Dolors not engage these picketers, who relish the media attention it gains them, and instead that they pray for them. Again, I believe the most prudent course of action is not to engage them verbally, through signs, etc. Smile, and offer up a prayer for them.*

Step 4 this week in our RCIA journey is **INVITATION**. Now that you have a relationship with your co-worker, neighbor, friend or family member, invite them to the next outreach event here at the parish! It won't be long before the annual celebration for the feast of Seven Dolors. The Knights of Columbus breakfasts will begin in September as well as Hospitality Sundays with the SDCW. 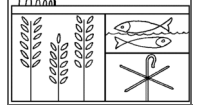

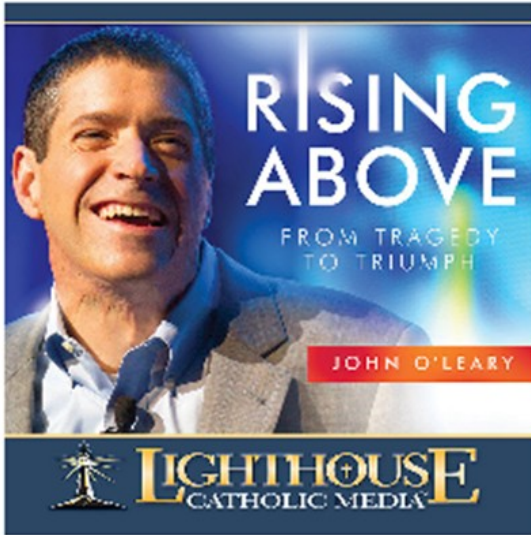

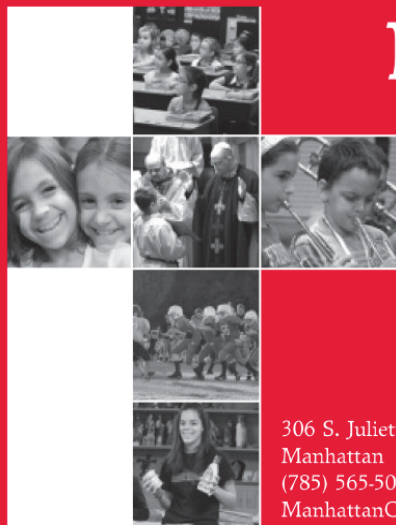

## Monsignor Arthur J. Luckey Endowment Fund

The Monsignor Luckey Endowment Fund was established in 2000. The fund honors Monsignor Arthur J. Luckey who gave 41 years of faithful service to the development of Seven Dolors Church and Manhattan Catholic Schools. Fr. Luckey arrived in Manhattan in 1913 to be a pastor of a struggling parish of only 25 families, one Sunday Mass and saddled with \$4000.00 in debt. After only seven years, Fr. Luckey succeeded in building the Seven Dolors Church, now listed on the National Registry of Historic Places. By his retirement in 1954, Seven Dolors Church and school had experienced tremendous growth and his record of achievement speaks for itself. Seven Dolors school, now Manhattan Catholic Schools, continues the vision Monsignor Luckey began nearly 100 years ago.

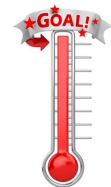
