**INFANT BAPTISM** Parents seeking to have their child baptized must call the parish office and schedule a preparation session, after which the baptism is scheduled.

**SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE** Couples seeking the Sacrament of Marriage must contact the parish at least 6 months prior to the intended date, and participate in sessions of preparation. Weddings are not scheduled in Advent or Lent.

**SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING** Those needing the Sacrament of Anointing may call the parish to schedule a time with one of the priests.

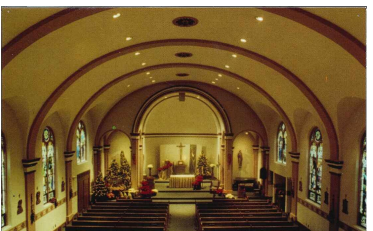
This image shows the Church in 1941 following vandalism, but depicts the style at that time.

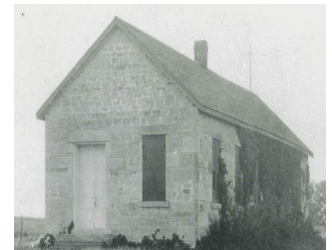

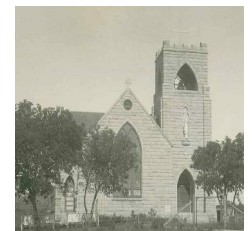
**Sacred Heart Academy was opened in 1908, as the first certified High School in Manhattan. It was housed in the Anderson House, purchased for \$14,000.00. Grades were added. In 1938 a separate building (the White Building) was purchased and moved next to the Academy. Msgr. Luckey High School was built in 1951 (cost \$208,000). The first wing (west) of the current grade school was added about 1955 (cost \$70,000), and then in 1962, the south wing and gymnasium were built (cost \$350,000). In the late 1980's, the white building destroyed by fire was replaced with a fine arts wing, and Seven Dolors Grade School and Msgr. Luckey Jr. High became known as Manhattan Catholic Schools.**



Seven Dolors Rectory was built in 1925 at a cost of \$10,000.



This is an image of St. Patrick's original Church built in 1959 and used until 1909. It is still used as part of the east portion of the Parish Hall.



This is an image of St. Patrick's 2nd Church built in 1909 until it burned in the 1938 fire.

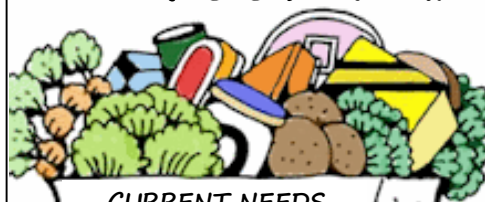

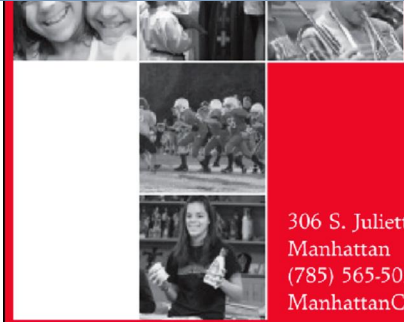
