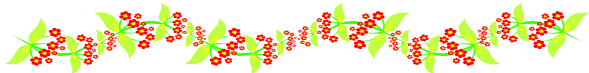

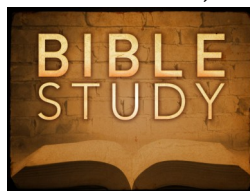

In the following weeks, you will read four steps that can help you to *spread the word* about RCIA – the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. We hope this can help you be confident in “being a disciple of Christ” through the Catholic Church.

**Step 1:** “We must begin to nurture friendships. Friendship was the original model of evangelization. The first Christians did not seek to spread the faith by means of political power, and they didn’t have the use of the mass media. They simply engaged in the oldest and most reliable method of influence – friendship. ‘Word of mouth’ endorsement by you about your Catholic faith and our parish can influence another to maybe seek out more information about the Catholic church.” (from *Rediscovering Catholicism* by Matthew Kelly.)

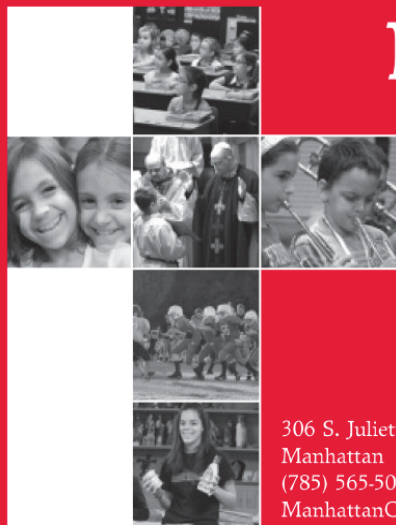

Next weekend, we will have our Annual Catholic Charities Appeal. This appeal is one of the primary sources of funding for this vital church ministry, which needs your help to continue providing assistance to families in our diocese who are in desperate situations. The following story about Leola's family represents *only one* of the many witnessed daily by the staff at Catholic Charities.

Leola's family was living on a tight budget. Her husband had suffered a disabling work injury so they relied on her income to pay the bills. Shortly after the delivery of their third child, their family budget became even tighter. They discovered their newborn had a heart condition that required frequent doctor visits. Leola was struggling to maintain her job and get her son to appointments in Kansas City. Time and money were both in short supply. The utility company was about to disconnect their service when Leola found her way to Catholic Charities, who (with your contributions) was able to assist her with utilities and food while also providing her with some basic skills in budgeting and personal finance. Catholic Charities staff extended *Hands of Hope* and offered **the light of Christ** to a family, preventing them from slipping into the darkness.

Too many of our brothers and sisters are sadly experiencing similar financial hardships. Recent statistics indicate that 1 in 4 Kansas children are growing up in poverty. As your Bishop, I am encouraging you to reach out to families like this by being a part of Catholic Charities. Often, we are so focused on our own daily routines and busy lives that we do not hear the cries of need from our neighbors. But as Christians we are called upon to bear one another's burdens—as Christ did for us. St. Matthew reminds us in the gospel "...whatever you did for the **least** of my brothers, you did for **me**."

If you have not already received an **appeal letter** mailed to your home, you can expect one soon from our **Executive Director, Michelle Martin**, requesting your assistance for our local Catholic Charities. This is your opportunity to assist your neighbors in need through Catholic Charities Annual Appeal next weekend. By making a contribution to Catholic Charities, you are helping the church to fulfill its duty to serve the poor and forgotten members within the 31 counties of our diocese. Any gift you make further promotes this ministry, so I ask you to consider making a contribution to Catholic Charities next weekend. Please bring the envelope with you to mass next weekend, or you can mail it directly to Catholic Charities. If for some reason you do not receive this mailing from Catholic Charities by next weekend, then your parish should have extra envelopes available next Sunday.

In closing, let us follow in the footsteps of Pope Francis and extend *Hands of Hope* to the impoverished and suffering of central and N.W. Kansas. With a contribution to our Catholic Charities you are helping to advance this ministry on behalf of your Church. Your donation will allow the staff at Catholic Charities to continue shining **a bright light of faith** for those who are journeying through some of the darkest moments in their lives. Let them know we are Christians by our love and generosity.

As always, I very sincerely appreciate the generosity you show Christ by sharing with the poor. May God bless you, and all that you do in His name.

Este es el Obispo Edward Weisenburger y les traigo el día de hoy un mensaje especial sobre las Caridades Católicas de la Diócesis de Salina. El próximo fin de semana tendremos nuestra Colección Anual para las Caridades Católicas. Esta campaña para recaudar fondos es una parte vital de nuestro ministro parroquial que necesita su ayuda para continuar ayudando a nuestras familias en la diócesis que se encuentran en situaciones difíciles. La historia de Leola representa solo uno de muchos casos que pasan por las oficinas de Caridades Católicas.

La familia de Leola estaba viviendo con un presupuesto muy limitado. Su marido se había lastimado en el trabajo y su familia solo contaba con los ingresos de ella para todas sus necesidades. Después nació su tercer hijo y el presupuesto se limitó aun más. Descubrieron que su bebé tenía una condición en el corazón que exigía visitas frecuentes al médico. Leola con dificultad podía asistir al trabajo y a todas las citas con el médico en Kansas City. Le falta tiempo y dinero. Estaban a punto de desconectarle la luz cuando Leola decidió pedir ayuda a las Caridades Católicas, que con su ayuda le brindaron asistencia y comida mientras también le enseñaban a mantener sus finanzas personales y a ahorrar. Los empleados de Caridades Católicas le ofrecieron a esta familia **Manos de Esperanza** y **la luz de Cristo** para que no se perdieran en las tinieblas.

Muchos de nuestros hermanos y hermanas, tristemente, pasan por situaciones financieras similares. Estadísticas recientes nos dicen que 1 de cada cuatro niños en Kansas crece en medio de la pobreza. Como su Obispo, les pido que por favor que ayuden a más familias como la que aquí mencionada por medio de una donación a las Caridades Católicas. Muchas veces por estar tan ocupados con nuestra rutina diaria no escuchamos las suplicas de ayuda de nuestros vecinos. Como Cristianos Dios nos llama a cargar la cruz de nuestros hermanos—asi como Cristo cargo la nuestra. San Mateo nos recuerda en el evangelio "... lo que hacen por el más **pequeño** de mis hermanos, lo hacen por **Mí**."

Si no han recibido una **carta de colección** en sus casas, recibirán una pronto del **Director Ejecutivo, Michelle Martin**, pidiendo su ayuda para la agencia de Caridades Católicas locales. Tome la oportunidad de este fin de semana para ayudar a sus vecinos necesitados por medio de la Campaña de Colección Anual de Caridades Católicas. Gracias a su donación las Caridades Católicas esta ayudando a la iglesia a cumplir su deber de asistir a los pobres y olvidados miembros de las familias en los 31 condados de nuestra diócesis. Cualquier regalo ayudara a nuestro ministerio así que le pido que considere ayudar a las Caridades Católicas este fin de semana. Por favor traiga su sobre el próximo fin de semana a misa, o puede enviarlo por correo directamente a las oficinas de Caridades Católicas.
