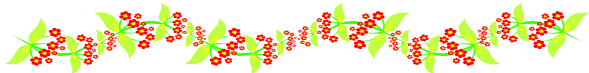

- **RELIGIOUS EDUCATION OPENING NIGHT WITH REGISTRATION**

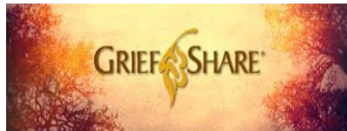


