INFANT BAPTISM Parents seeking to have their child baptized must call the parish office and schedule a preparation session, after which the baptism is scheduled.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE Couples seeking the Sacrament of Marriage must contact the parish at least 6 months prior to the intended date, and participate in sessions of preparation. Weddings are not scheduled in Advent or Lent.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING Those needing the Sacrament of Anointing may call the parish to schedule a time with one of the priests.

World Youth Day 2014—October 26th

World Youth Day is not just a day or an experience, but an ongoing pilgrimage of faith for young people. These special days and celebrations are meant to rejuvenate and reinvigorate the spiritual life of youth and young adults along their pilgrim journey, which ultimately leads to Christ Jesus.

Pope John Paul II announced the institution of World Youth Day in December, 1985, as an annual gathering of youth and young adults for prayer, worship and celebration of the Catholic faith. The event is observed annually in dioceses and every two to three years at an international gathering.



The purpose of World Youth Day is threefold

1. **Putting Trust in the Young** World Youth Day is a coming together of young adults from the four corners of the world and a strong reminder of the strength and confidence the young bring to the Church today.
2. **Gathering Together** World Youth Day is not simply a gathering for the young people of the world, but a time to put trust in the world's youth. A calling for the world's youth to come together as one people.
3. **Meeting the International World on a Human Level** It is still a marvel in this the 21st Century to exchange with others and to be a part of an international experience. International events are able to stir much hope but also many fears (increase in fundamentalism, nationalism and other new conflicts. . .) The Church and Christians themselves have a role to play in preventing the development of these fears, and in aiding each person in finding their way and discovering hope.

All Saints Day/Parish Clean Up Day

- ◆ **November 1 - Feast of All Saints** This year the Feast of All Saints falls on Saturday, thus the obligation is removed. However, there will be Mass for the Holy Day at 8 AM.
- ◆ **November 2 - Feast of All Souls** This year, the feast of All Souls falls on Sunday and replaces the celebration of 31st Sunday in Ordinary Time.
- ◆ **November 9 - the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica** falls on Sunday and replaces the 32nd Sunday of Ordinary Time. Prayers and Readings for that weekend will reflect this feast.
