



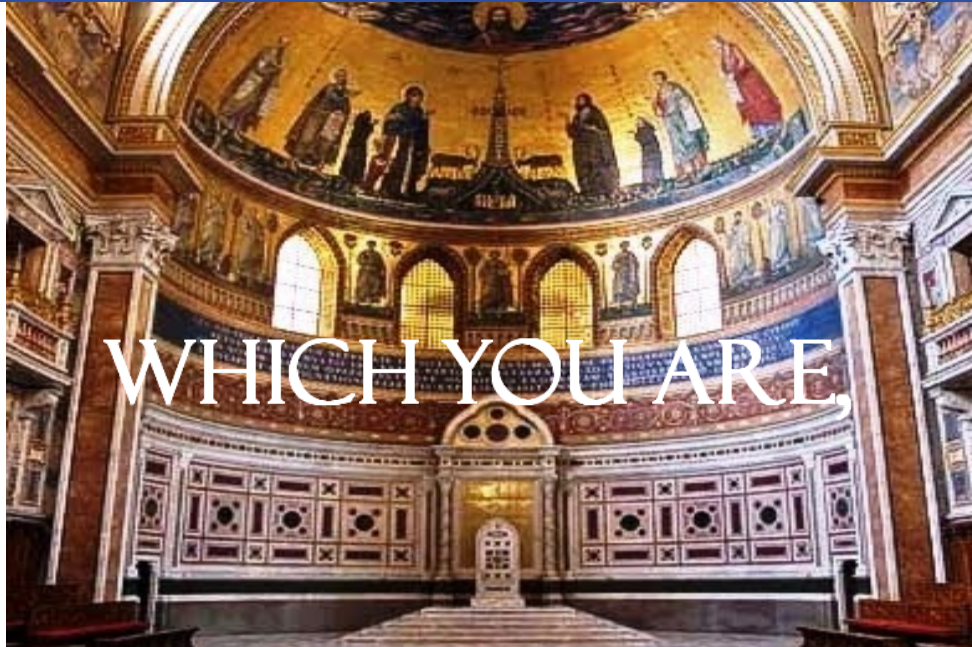

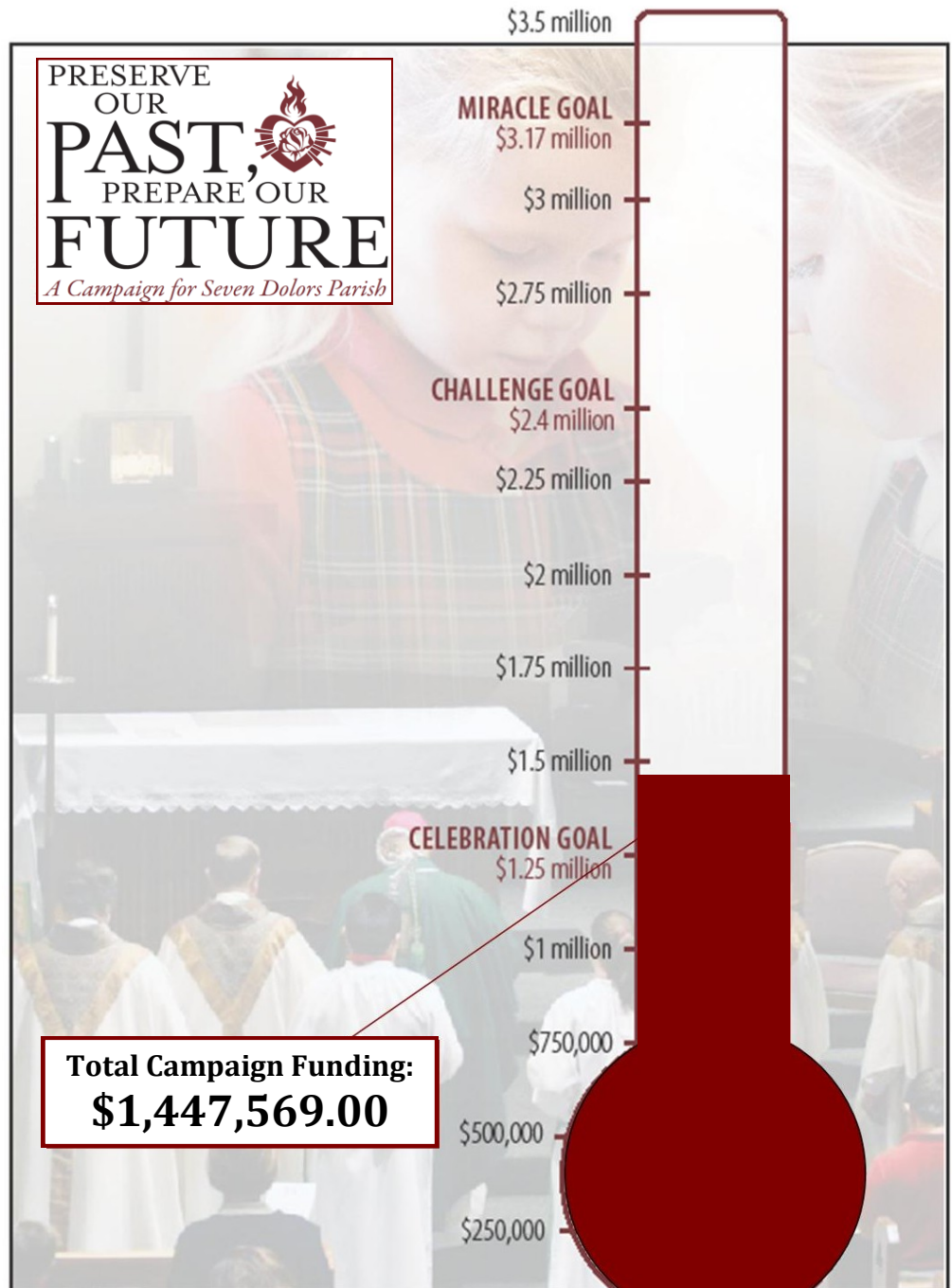

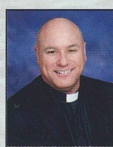
Prayer for Vocations
