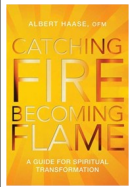

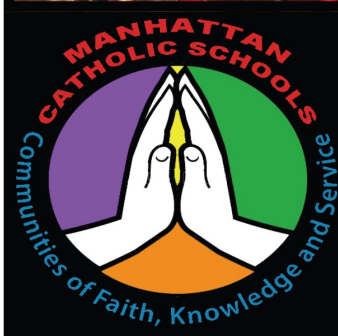

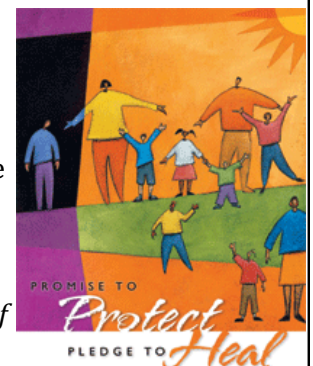


### ABUSE OF MINORS PASTORAL RESPONSE HOTLINE 785-825-0865
