



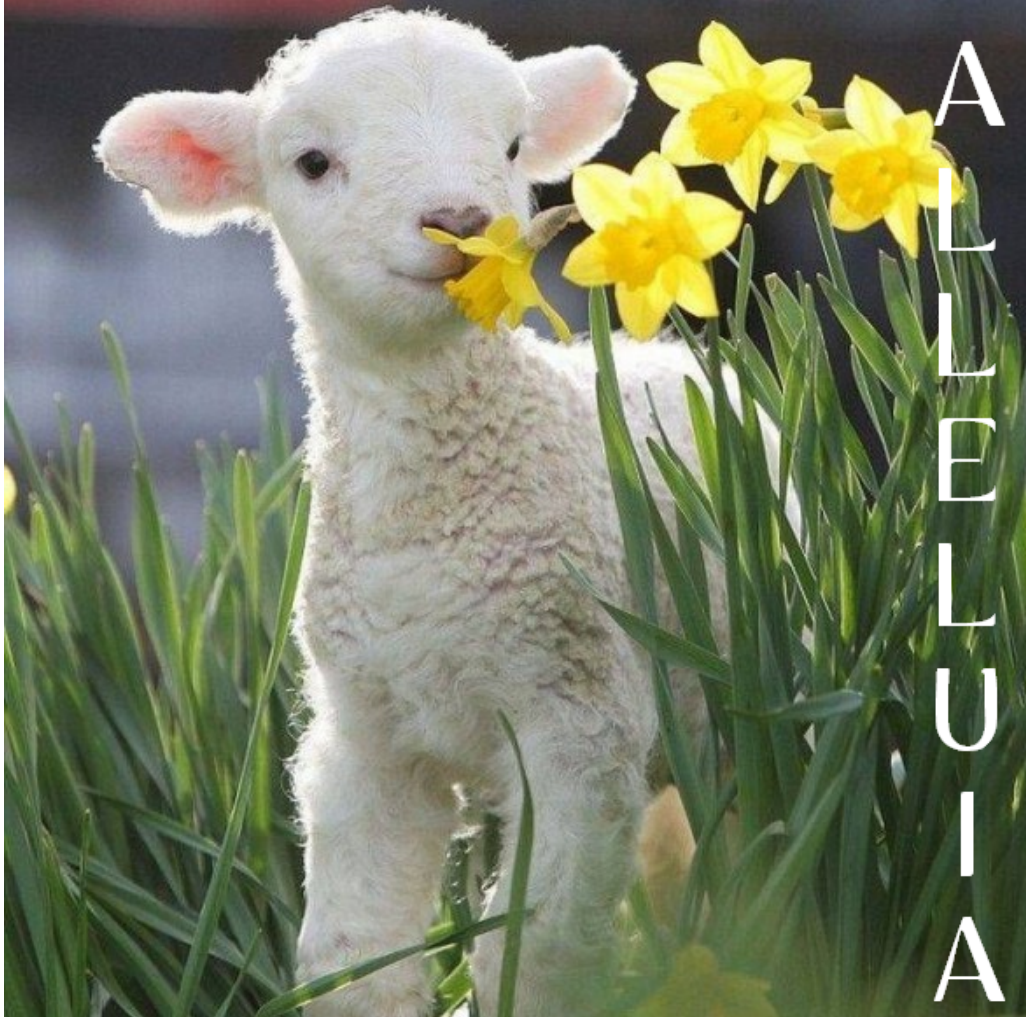

APRIL 5, 2015 EASTER SUNDAY



**Easter Sunday:** When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the tomb and saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place. Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed.

**Second Sunday of Easter:** Jesus said to Thomas, "Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed."

How many times have we heard the phrase: Seeing is believing!

In fact, we live our lives by this basic scientific principal – making decisions and choices that dictate the path of our lives. How contrary is the call of the Gospel – to believe without seeing! We are not able to peer into an empty tomb or place our fingers in the nail marks of Jesus – but we have been witnesses of the passion journey of Jesus that was enabled by Jesus' love for humanity; for

you and I. This love of Jesus is fortified in the actions of love and compassion of our brothers and sisters each day of our lives. After the 40 days of Lent, let us celebrate the 50 days of Easter celebrating what Jesus has done for us, and challenging ourselves to reflect that love in our words and actions. For when others see the love of Christ in us – seeing will be believing.

**Domingo de Pascua:** En eso llegó también Simón Pedro, que lo venía siguiendo, y entró en el sepulcro. Entonces entró también el otro discípulo, el que había llegado primero al sepulcro, y vio y creyó. **Segundo Domingo de Pascua:** Jesús añadió a Tomas: "Tú crees porque me has visto; dichosos los que creen sin haber visto". ¿Cuántas veces hemos oído la frase: Ver para creer! De hecho, vivimos nuestras vidas por este director científico básico - la toma de decisiones y elecciones que dictan el camino de nuestra vida. Cómo contrario es el llamado del Evangelio - a creer sin ver! No somos capaces de mirar en una tumba vacía o colocar los dedos en las marcas de los clavos de Jesús - pero hemos sido testigos de viaje pasión de Jesús que fue habilitada por Jesús amor por la humanidad, para usted y para mí Este amor de Jesús es fortificada en las acciones de amor y la compasión de nuestros hermanos y hermanas cada día de nuestras vidas. Después de los 40 días de la Cuaresma, celebremos los 50 días de Pascua la celebración de lo que Jesús ha hecho por nosotros, y desafiando a nosotros mismos para reflejar ese amor en nuestras palabras y acciones. Para cuando los demás ven el amor de Cristo en nosotros - visión será creer.

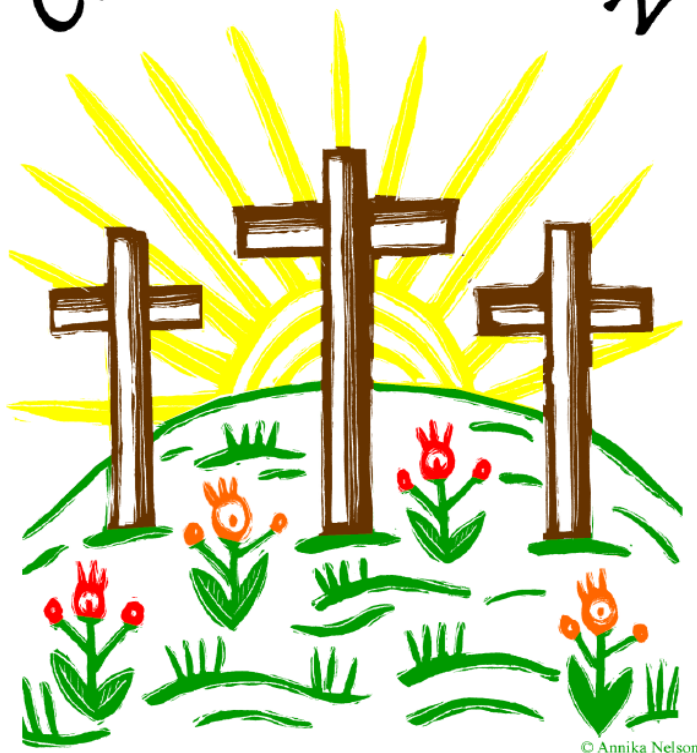

FOR PERPETUAL EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

**What is Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration?**

Perpetual Adoration is simply our response to Jesus' love for us. Each person spends a QUIET HOUR OF PRAYER in His Eucharistic Presence once a week on a regular basis. All the hours are organized in such a way that each hour is covered by at least one or two people. The chapel is always open for anyone who may want to visit. Individuals commit to their one hour prayer time that is scheduled once a week.

**The St. Joseph's Chapel for Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration**

Our chapel opened on March 19, 1995 in the former chapel of the St. Joseph's Convent (now the Parish Offices). It was named in honor of St. Joseph and the Sisters of Saint Joseph in 2010. The Adoration Chapel is open to the entire community. We have regular adorers from Seven Dolores Parish, St. Thomas More Parish, St. Isidore's Student Center, St. Patrick's Parish in Ogden and surrounding areas. Perpetual adoration is made possible through people like you who have committed themselves to one hour of prayer each week. We have many people who have taken more than one hour and several who come and visit the Blessed Sacrament daily. Because of changing schedules and people moving out of Manhattan, we are always in need of adorers. # SEVEN DOLORS FOOD PANTRY



Seven Dolores Food Pantry strives to provide nutritious and adequate food for those less fortunate in our community. We function in association with the Flint Hills Breadbasket and are one of five church food pantries. We are open on Thursday afternoons; however, there is a pantry open each day, Monday through Friday. All clients are pre-approved by the Breadbasket before they can receive food from the pantries. Over the past 12 months we have served 2,207 men, women and children.

We are blessed to have so many generous donors: Each week we receive non-perishable food from the parishioners of Seven Dolores and St. Thomas More as well as cash donations to purchase items in short supply; we receive meat, milk, eggs, margarine, and any other needed available items from the Breadbasket; each month we receive approximately 50 lbs. of meat items from St. Thomas More parishioners as part of the

Prairie Land Food program and each week, we pick up slightly blemished produce donated by Ray's Apple Market.

Every year we receive sizable donations of non-perishable foods from the Knights of Columbus food drive during Lent and the Manhattan Catholic Schools food drives.

Non-perishable food donations may be left in the church gathering space or brought to the Parish Center office.

The food pantry is operated solely by volunteers who find it very rewarding to help these individuals and seldom leave this ministry. For any volunteer opportunities you may use the Time, Talent, and Treasure forms or call the parish office.

*The Family Center Budget Shop is an organization staffed entirely by volunteers from local parishes and the community. It is under the sponsorship and ownership of Seven Dolores Parish. A committee including representatives from Seven Dolores and St. Thomas More parishes involved in the shop operation is advised by the Seven Dolores pastor. Our income is used for the benefit of Manhattan Catholic Schools, the local parishes, and other community needs as approved by the committee.*

Dear Community,

Spring is the season of renewal. As we eagerly anticipate Easter, we reflect as a school family our positive climate and vitality of our school onto the community. Our students have displayed their understanding of their Faith in many ways during Lent. The 8<sup>th</sup> grade has performed "Living Stations of the Cross", students bought or brought books to give to the children's pediatric unit of the hospital, they collected clothing for the needy and raised money for the "Rice Bowl" campaign sponsored

by the Catholic Church. This year we supplied CASA with clothing for children who were displaced from their homes and in the past have had coat drives, have visited nursing homes and helped the community with many other school and community activities. Our students understand and are willing to serve others as part of their Catholic school teachings. We have Mass twice a week and have daily religion classes with our Faith infused with Catholic teachings in all subjects whenever possible.

Our students thrive academically even though we are at Manhattan Catholic Schools for our Christian beliefs. We have the best assessment scores in Manhattan. Our veteran staff of educators strive to give our students not only the best religious education, but the best academic education in all subject areas. We set high standards for the students and have expectations that the students will achieve an exceptional standard of excellence. We are continually reviewing our curriculum to improve student success, making changes when we feel they are necessary. All of our teachers are licensed and almost 50% of them have Master's degrees. We are an accredited school through the state of Kansas and AdvancED. USD 383 provides a resource room for any student that qualifies for assistance and we have a Title I teacher in place for help with emerging readers. We have many students in the gifted program as well.

We have many extra-curricular activities at MCS. We belong to the Blue Valley League for athletics. We compete in football, volleyball, basketball, and track. Our Scholar's Bowl team has won the league title 10 out of last 11 years. We compete in the National Spelling Bee, Geographic Bee and the National History Bee, where we have qualified 2-4 students nationally since its inception three years ago. We have had students selected for Honor's band and choir festivals. We have a dedicated art teacher for all our students and plan for the return of Family and Consumer Science classes.

Our future is very bright! We just completed our capital campaign and will start improvement projects next summer. Utilizing the \$2 million raised by the community, we will implement needed changes that will improve the educational environment of the school. With the return of preschool for three and four year old students, the updated technology the past few years and capital improvements looming in the near future, there should be no reservations about sending your children to Manhattan Catholic Schools. Studies indicate a vast majority of volunteers for Churches and much of the contributions given come from those that have attended Catholic schools.

**Education is important in the formation of the human person, it teaches how to live well now so as to be able to live with God for all eternity.**

Parents, you are the first and most important teachers in your child's spiritual formation. This formation began when you publicly announced your desire to baptize your child, marked their head with the sign of the cross, renounced Satan and reaffirmed your profession of faith, carried your child to the baptismal waters, held a lighted candle and received a blessing as parents of your child. Your child's faith formation is also a parish responsibility, and that's where our Religious Education program comes in. Our goals are to assist parents and their children in their faith journeys by increasing their knowledge of faith and deepening their relationship with our Lord.

Seven Dolores offers a complete religious formation program for Pre-K through 12th Grade. This includes the preparation and celebration of **First Reconciliation** and **Communion** (2nd Grade) and **Confirmation** (9th Grade). We meet Wednesday evenings from 6:30-8pm, September – April. Registration is mandatory and begins in August. We also invite parents and parishioners to open their hearts and minds and become catechists in our program. It is amazing how much your faith will grow as you share the knowledge you have with our youth.
