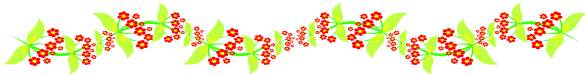

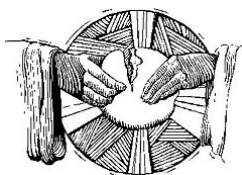

An Appeal for Nepal from the Bishop

Nepal Earthquake Collection: As by now most of us know, a 7.8-magnitude earthquake struck Nepal on April 25th, toppling buildings and homes, causing widespread panic, and claiming thousands of lives. A special collection will be taken up at all Masses next weekend, **May 16-17**. Our Church mourns the terrible suffering of our brothers and sisters affected by this catastrophe. Please join with the Catholic community across the U.S. in responding to our suffering brothers and sisters through a special collection for the works of **Catholic Relief Services** in Nepal. **CRS** has already begun a major response to this crisis, providing 10,000 families (50,000 people) with emergency shelter materials, blankets, water treatment and hygiene kits. Given the scale of the disaster, the agency expects to expand relief activities. Your assistance is greatly appreciated. Checks for this special collection may be written to your local parish who will combine the funds and forward them to the Diocese.
