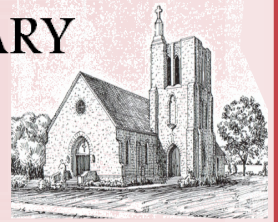

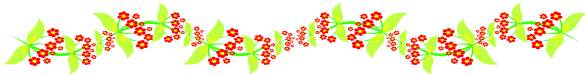

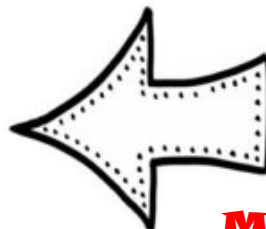

- Enter the main driveway for parking. Please park in the spaces in front of the building.

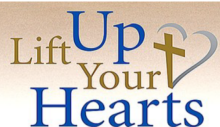
