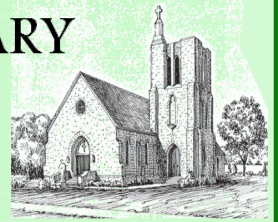

JUNE PARISH INTENTION: That, during our time of transition, our community will find renewal and revitalization in the coming months, growing together and ever closer to Christ.

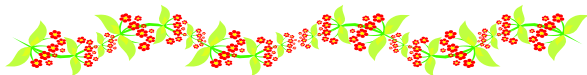

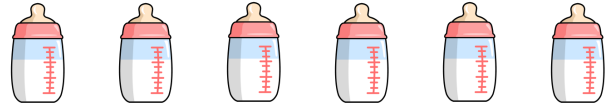
It doesn't take me very long before I hear God's voice telling me: "Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?"

Seven Dolors Presence on P&A Team

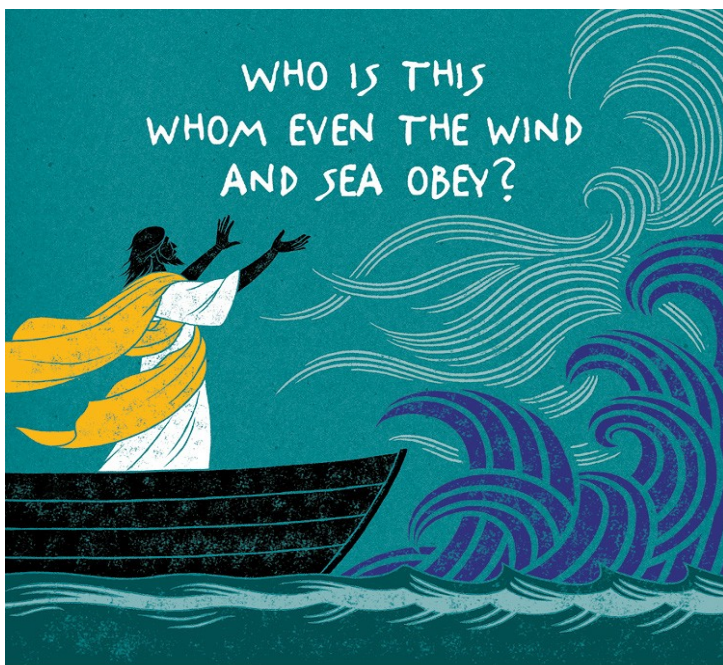
