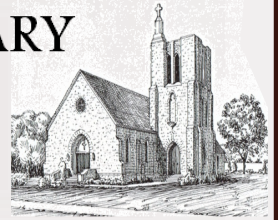
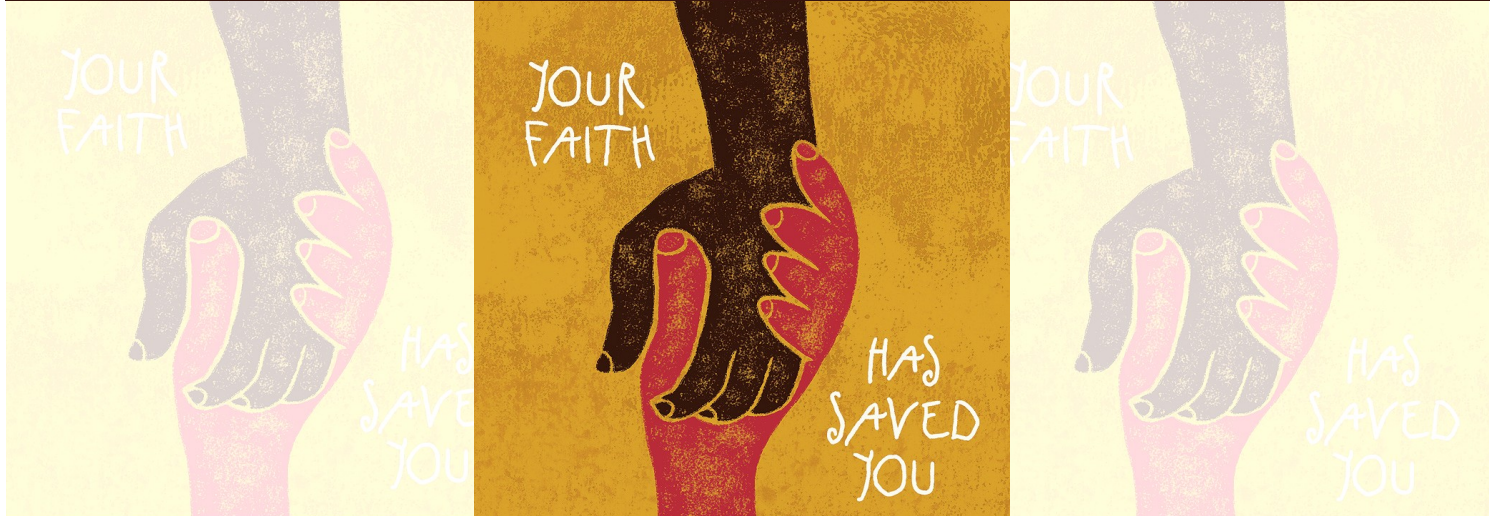

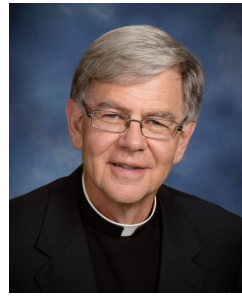
From Rosie's Desk –

FR. KERRY NINEMIRE...**

Born Nov. 8, 1949, in Norton to Raymond and Imogene Ninemire of New Almelo, Father Kerry Ninemire graduated from St. Francis

Seminary High School in Victoria, then St. Mary's College in St. Mary, Ky., and Kenrick Seminary in St. Louis. He was ordained June 13, 1975, at St. Joseph Church in New Almelo by Bishop Cyril Vogel.

He was named parochial vicar of Seven Dolores Parish in Manhattan in 1975, then parochial vicar at Sacred Heart Cathedral in Salina in 1981.

He was named pastor of Sacred Heart Parish in Oberlin and Assumption of Mary Parish in Herndon as part of a team ministry project. He then was named parochial vicar of St. Mary, Queen of the Universe Parish in Salina in 1986 and became pastor of St. Thomas More Parish in Manhattan in 1991. He was named pastor of SS. Philip and James Parish in Phillipsburg and St. Francis Parish in Claudell in 1995, then returned to St. Mary in Salina in 1997 as pastor. He was named pastor of St. Francis Xavier Parish in Junction City, and named vicar general, both in 2013. Seven Dolores welcomes him as pastor as of July 1st, 2015.

Evangelization Commission




