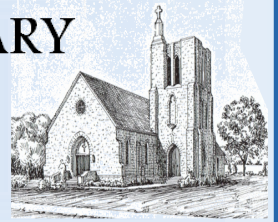

JULY PARISH INTENTION: For all priests and parishes in our diocese, that this time of change will be one of renewal.

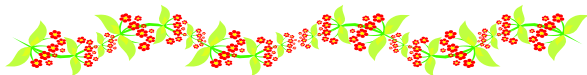
