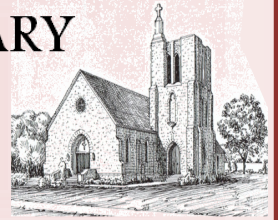

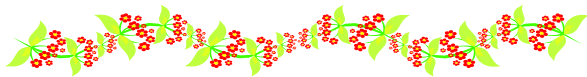

'Word of mouth' endorsement by you about your Catholic faith and our parish can influence another to maybe seek out more information about the Catholic church." (from *Rediscovering Catholicism* by Matthew Kelly.)

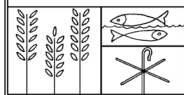
