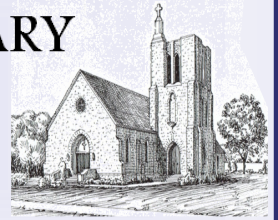

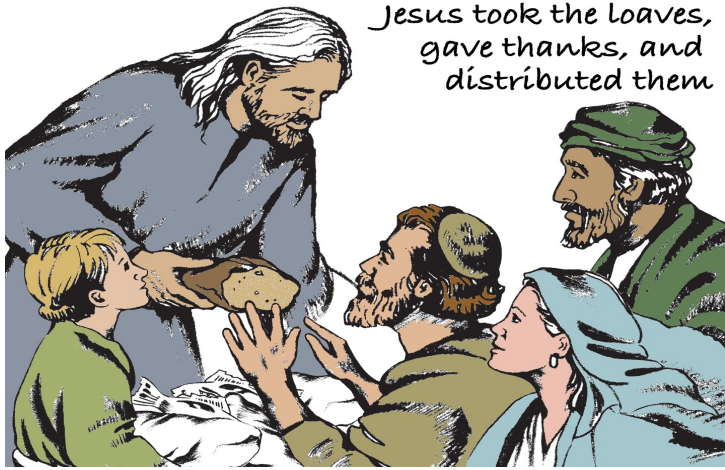

PARISH LIFE COMMISSION

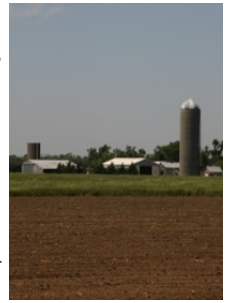
