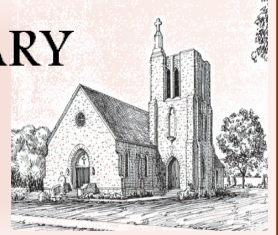
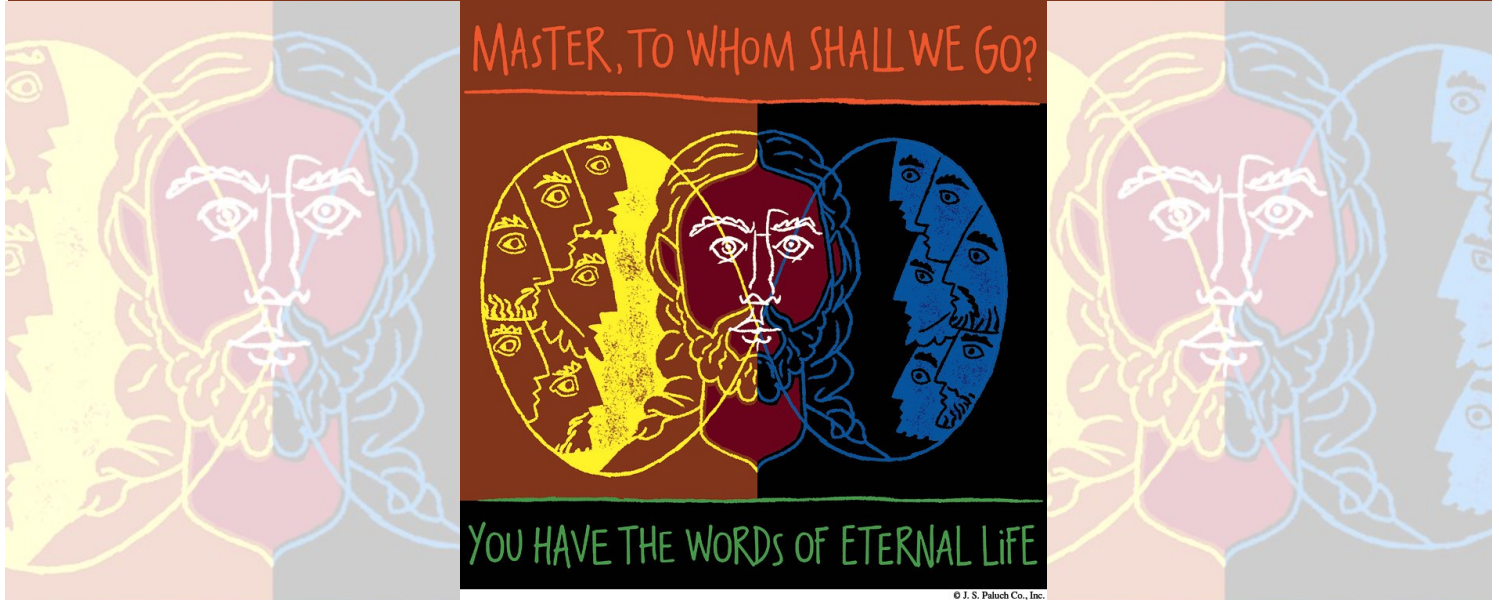

**From Rosie's Desk –**

This Sunday's second reading has me watching husbands and wives in the assembly because I've noticed in the past that when this reading is proclaimed, they start elbowing each other or give each other a glance or stare. In actuality, this reading is probably the most misunderstood in Scripture. In the Scripture class that I took at Aquinas in St. Louis, the professor made sure we read it un-emotional! One has to look at the people who were being addressed and what the culture was at the time etc., plus one has to look deeper. Paul compares husband and wife with Christ and the Church. What is his point? Compare and contrast the woman (the bride) who has a difficult childbirth and the Church with the birth of new ideas. An example of the latter would be some of the family problems addressed in the meetings of the Extraordinary Assembly of the Synod of Bishops. Sometime this week, ask yourself – "What problems from living in today's world cause difficulty for you in living your faith/religion?"

## THE PARISH FINANCE COUNCIL

Parish Finance Council assists the pastor in the administration of parish temporal matters. An active, well-formed Parish Finance Council is a key element for promoting the financial health of a parish, assuring accountability to the parish and assisting the pastor with his temporal responsibilities. In the administration of temporal goods of the parish, Canon 532 defines the role of the pastor as the authoritative representative of the parish.

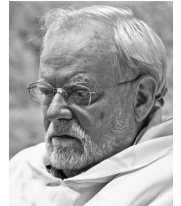
*"The pastor represents the parish in all juridic affairs in accord with the norm of law; he is to see to it that the goods of the parish are administered in accord with the norms of canons 1281-1288."*

Canon 537 introduces the Parish Finance Council as a mandated body having an **advisory** and **consultative** role with the pastor.

*"Each parish is to have a finance council which is regulated by universal law as well as by norms issued by the diocesan bishop; in this council the Christian faithful, selected according to the same norms, aid the pastor in the administration of parish goods with due regard for the prescription of canon 532."*


