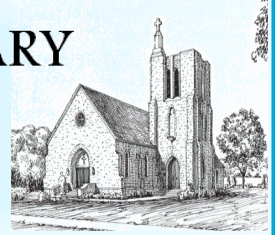

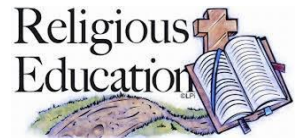
LAY ECCLESIAL MINISTRY

Are you dealing with the death of your spouse, a parent, a sibling, a child or a friend? Come to any or all of a series of meetings to help you understand, cope, and heal through a process called **GriefShare**. Whether it's

been one month, one year or 10 years, **GriefShare** can help you heal from the loss of your loved one. Each week the group will watch a video seminar on DVD. Our next meeting of **GriefShare** is Tuesday, September 1. The topic is "**The Journey of Grief – Part One**." Since the death of your loved one, you've started a journey. It's not a trip you planned, but it's a trip you must take. Several factors will shape your journey and you can take intentional steps to point yourself in a healthy, healing direction. 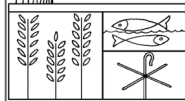

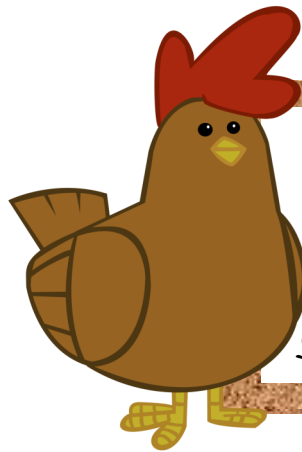
